Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Friday NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.	
Day 2 - Saturday PORTOVENERE	This fishing village was an important maritime centre until the 15th century. Its old pastel-coloured houses clinging to the hillside and its narrow intertwining streets demonstrate that it has retained its authenticity. Ship at anchor, water sports.	
Day 3 - Sunday SAINT-FLORENT	The picturesque and enchanting ancient Roman city of Saint-Florent sits at the bottom of the gulf that bears its name. Here, the turquoise sea edges the incredibly beautiful white sandy beaches. Boat at anchor, beach and water sports available.	
Day 4 - Monday ANTIBES	Unspoiled and authentic, its historic centre, surrounded by 15th century ramparts, is home to Château Grimaldi and the Picasso Museum, narrow streets and little squares, a Provençal market and a cathedral decorated with a baroque facade. Ship at anchor, no water sports.	
Day 5 - Tuesday NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. Excursions of your cruise

Day 2 - Saturday PORTOVENERÉ / DISCOVERY OF PORTOVENERE (1/2 day)*

Start your tour on foot by passing through the ancient arch to Caruggio Portovenere. This unique little village on the Ligurian coast is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site You will be able to enjoy the amazing view of Andrea Doria Castle with its imposing structure, before heading back towards the port, taking in the panoramic view over the town and the three islands. Your guided tour ends with a tasting of the delicious local wine and some of the local products that have made the region famous for its gastronomy.

Day 2 - Saturday PORTOVENERE / CAP SUR LES CINQUE TERRE*

Clinging to the Ligurian cliffs are five villages - Monterosso, Vernazza, Corniglia, Manarola and Riomaggiore. Marvel as you approach this magnificent coast with its villages suspended above the sea. As you disembark by local ferry boat, you will discover the beautiful village of Monterosso. 3 hours excursion. Allow 1 hour of navigation to reach the villages. (this excursion depends on weather and sea conditions)

Day 3 - Sunday ST FLORENT / THE AGRIATES DESERT IN 4X4 & BOAT (1/2 day)*

Discover the Agriates desert aboard an all-terrain vehicle and sail along its white sand beaches, Saleccia and Lotu. You will enjoy free time to swim in its turquoise waters.

Day 3 - Sunday ST FLORENT PATRIMONIO & WINE (1/2 day)*

The Orenga de Ga≣ory estate is a family estate founded 53 years ago by the father, Pierre, of the current managing winemaker, Henri Orenga de Gaffory. Winemaker, but also passionate about and collector of contemporary art, who organizes each stall

Day 4 - Monday ANTIBES / ALONG THE STREETS OF ST PAUL DE VENCE (1/2 day, morning)*

Accompanied by your guide, travel across the historic center of Saint Paul de Vence and discover its history and its rich heritage, including the magnificent chapel of the white penitents.. Take time to stroll in the narrow streets and to admire the artists' studios, the painting galleries and the handicrafts stalls. At the foot of the thousand-year-old walls of this medieval village, discover the mythical square where Yves Montand and Lino Ventura disputed unforgettable games of « pétanque ».



Formalities

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
