





# Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday FORT-DE-FRANCE	The largest of the French West Indian towns blends cosmopolitan style and local colour, with its urban lifestyle, colourful markets, metal architecture and charming old houses. Stopover for boarding and disembarking. Ship docked in port.
Day 2 - Sunday MARIE-GALANTE	Windmills bear witness to the sugar industry that played such a major role in the history of this charming island with its magnificent beaches. It still produces the world's best rum. At anchor. Beach and water sports.
Day 3 - Monday ANTIGUA	The jagged coast of this former British colony is studded with magnificent beaches. Its typical port, with lively pubs and inns, gives it reams of historic charm. Ship at anchor, water sports available, beach.
Day 4 - Tuesday SAINT MARTIN	Magnificent coves, hills, long strips of sand separated by a few sea lagoons and no less than 74 nationalities rub shoulders on this island where a simple welcome sign marks the border between France and Holland. Boat docked, beach, dive locker closed.
Day 5 - Wednesday ANGUILLA	A long strip of amazingly white sand delicately posed on turquoise water. This miniature island attracts the VIPs of this world, who love its intimacy and discretion. Ship at anchor, water sports available, beach.
Day 6 - Thursday PRICKLY PEAR / VIRGIN GORDA	Privatization of a beach on Prickly Pear Island for the Caribbean Beach Club day. Guests who have booked the "Virgin Gorda Panoramas" excursion will discover an amazing geological curiosity: large granite boulders softened by erosion, creating natural emerald pools lined with white sand. Boats at anchor, beach and water sports.
Day 7 - Friday NEVIS	This tiny volcanic island, sister island to St Kitts, where the traditional sport of cricket remains a national game, is a fascinating world of hot water springs, archeological sites and forests inhabited by green monkies. AShip at anchor, water sports available, beach.

Day 2 - Sunday
MARIE GALANTE -
ISLAND TOUR (1/2 day
- morning)*

A wonderful introduction to Marie Galante, carefully curated by our expert local guides. Visit to the Château Murat (1807) and its beautiful grounds, a rum tasting at the Labat distillery, and then a return to St Louis. You couldn't wish for a better initiation into the wonders of the Lesser Antilles.

#### Day 3 - Monday ANTIGUA/SWIM WITH THE RAYS'

Adrenalin guaranteed for a rendez-vous with pastenague rays. After a 30-minute bus ride and a ride in a speedboat, you'll get to Stingray City for a super, safe, sensory experience. Even non-swimmers can see these strange and gracious creatures twirling through the shallow water.

#### Day 3 - Monday ANTIGUA - BALADE DÉCOUVERTE EN 4\*4°

The discovery of the island off the beaten track is done in all-terrain vehicles. You will leave the English countryside in the tropics with its authentically charming hamlets and its remains of old refineries attesting to the intense sugar activity before crossing the luxuriant tropical forest. You will not miss the swimming break on the magnificent Caribbean coast.

#### Day 4 - Tuesday SAINT MARTIN PANORAMA OF ST MARTIN\*

Take the chairlift for an easy and effortless ride up to the highest point of the Dutch part of Saint Martin and enjoy 360 degree panoramic views out

#### Day 4 - Tuesday SAINT MARTIN PANORAMA AND ZIPLINE (1/2 day morning)

Ascend the highest peak to admire the Dutch side of Saint Martin as well as a 360 degree view over the island. Then get your adrenaline flowing with the world's steepest zip line! It's a breathtaking descent that only the most adventurous will brave.

## Day 5 - Wednesday ANGUILLA / BEACH CLUB (1/2 day)

## Day 6 - Thursday VIRGIN GORDA/ PANORAMA\*

### Day 7 - Friday NEVIS/ISLAND HIGHLIGHTS AND BOTANICAL GARDEN\*

This highly popular tour includes a visit to Hamilton House, birthplace of Alexander Hamilton, one of the USA's founding fathers. Day 8 - Saturday FORT DE FRANCE / FROM THE CELLAR TO THE BOTTLE (DISTILLERIE A 1710)\*

Learn about the rum making process at the rum distillry Habitation A1710 located in Le François. Bottling and cellar work will no longer hold any secrets for you. Take advantage of these moments with the cellar master who will be happy to share with you his most beautiful creations.

## **Formalities**

#### **HEALTH FORMALITIES**

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
