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Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday FORT-DE-FRANCE	The largest of the French West Indian towns blends cosmopolitan style and local colour, with its urban lifestyle, colourful markets, metal architect and charming old houses. Stopover for boarding and disembarking. Ship docked in port. This lush volcanic island, home to the last Caribbean Indians, has almost as many rivers as there are days in the year. Mother Nature reigns supre At anchor. Water sports, no beach.	
Day 2 - Sunday LA DOMINIQUE		
Day 3 - Monday MAYREAU	The smallest of the Grenadine Islands has just one little village, surrounded by idyllic beaches with the finest sand, crystal clear waters and multicoloured tropical fish. Ship at anchor, water sports available (no water skiing), beach. Private beach for the Caribbean Beach Club.	
Day 4 - Tuesday GRENADE	This small island territory is home to fragrant nutmeg, cinnamon and vanilla. A succession of colonial influences has left a fascinating heritage of architectural curiosities. Ship at anchor, no water sports, no direct access to a beach.	
Day 5 - Wednesday TOBAGO CAYS	A dazzling array of blues on the most beautiful coral reef in the Grenadines. Tropical fish sport the most fascinating colours in these crystal clear waters. Ship at anchor, water sports available (no water skiing), beach.	
Day 6 - Thursday SAINT-PIERRE	Known as the Little Paris of the French West Indies, the island was the capital of the aristocracy of the plantations until 1902, when at 7.50 on 8 the volcano exploded and in 3 minutes St Pierre was buried under a carpet of lava. This is an emotional visit with a wealth of history. Ship at ar water sports available, beach.	
Day 7 - Friday DESHAIES	On the most lush side of the lle Papillon, Deshaies is a perfect example of the simple charms of Creole life. Time stands still in these tranquil fit villages surrounded by gentle green hills. At anchor. Beach and water sports.	
Day 8 - Saturday SAINT MARTIN	Magnificent coves, hills, long strips of sand separated by a few sea lagoons and no less than 74 nationalities rub shoulders on this island where a swelcome sign marks the border between France and Holland. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.	











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Excursions of your cruise

Day 2 - Sunday
ROSEAU/ UNUSUAL
SWIMS IN DOMINICA
(1/2 day)*

Travel to the untamed summits of the island, and after a short walk you will come to a natural rock pool and narrow canyon fed by a waterfall where you can swim surrounded by nature. (Undeveloped natural site).

Continue to the village of Wotten Waven, also known as the Wellness Village for its therapeutic pools fed by hot sulphur water. Be sure to take a soothing bath in the midst of fumaroles and porous volcanic rocks.

Day 2 - Sunday ROSEAU/ NATURAL WONDERS OF DOMINICA (1/2 day)* Come and enjoy the most popular natural attractions that Dominica has to offer!

Spanny Falls are still a bit of a secret, even though they are the height of a 7-story building. Continue on to the Trois Pitons National Park, and cross the forest to the Emerald Pool and its 12-metre waterfall where you can cool off (undeveloped area).

You will finally make your way to the village of Trafalgar to the viewing platform to see the majestic waterfalls that the village is famous for before

returning to the boat.

Day 3 - Monday MAYREAU / CATAMARAN, THE **HEART OF THE** GRENADINES (1/2 day)

his postcard morning accompanied by an atmosphere and a purely Caribbean cocktail on board will take you to the translucent anchorages around the island of Mayreau. The climate, always suitable for swimming, will encourage you to refresh yourself in the turquoise waters of the Grenadines unless you prefer to tread on the sparkling sand.

Day 4 - Tuesday GRENADA / LA CAPIJE (1/2 day - morning)*

You'll start this magnificent forest trekking at "Grand Etang". It'll take you through a plantation where you'll see cocoa, nutmeg and bananas, and then on to the bamboo waterfalls where you can enjoy a refreshing swim. Crossing the river: so wet sneakers

Day 4 - Tuesday GRENADA/ WATERFALLS AND CHOCOLATE (1/2 day)*

This aromatic island tour will allow you to get to know everything about the "Jouvay" organic chocolate production at the Diamond Chocolate Factory nestled in the village of Victoria on the west coast of Grenada. You'll find it in an 18th-century converted rum distillery, which was built by French monks. Nowadays, the factory's responsible for making 'Jouvay' – one of the world's top 10 chocolates, according to National Geographic. This chocolate's completely organic and you'll learn how it's made – from the harvest of the cocoa beans, to watching them dry on trays under the Caribbean sun. A visit to the garden of cocoa trees to see, cocoa, cloves, chili, nutmeg, flowers, fruits, followed by a delicious chocolate tasting, will conclude this pleasant visit to one of the most amazing sites in the Caribbean. On your way back, you make a detour to enjoy a swim (conditions permitting) in the natural lovely pool at the Concord Falls. Here the nutmeg and cocoa trees grow along the flanks of the hills in the tropical forest that is forever near. Please note: guests are advised to wear a swimsuit under a cover-up, bring sunscreen, a hat, sunglasses, and a towel. The order of the stops may vary. Guests must be at least 5 years old to participate. Long way by bus to discover the magnificience of the island.

Day 4 - Tuesday GRENADA / FORT AND BEACHE BY LOCAL BUS (1/2 day - afternoon)*

You'll discover St Georges - the charming capital, known as the Little San Francisco of the West Indies - in a vintage truck. You'll stop at the Frederick Fort that look out over the town, and after a detour in the nearby hills, where you'll have a great view of the interior of the island, you'll have the chance to swim from one of Grenada's most beautiful beaches.

Day 4 - Tuesday GRENADA / ISLAND TOUR (day)*

The Spice Island is as rich in aromas as in landscapes. You will visit the famous Diamond Chocolate factory in Victoria, which produces Jouvay chocolate, ranked among the best chocolates in the world. In addition, Different stops will allow you to discover the luxuriant nature of this authentic island Finally, you will enjoy a local lunch at the Belmont Estate in an 18th century cocoa plantation.

TOBAGO CAYS CATAMARAN MORPION ISLAND (1/2 day)*

Morpion - also known as Mopio - will make your paradise island dream come true! A tiny white sand island with a straw hut and palm tree leaf roof, the main function of this speck of paradise is to indicate the way to sailors. This highly photogenic spot has featured in magazines worldwide: today, it's all

Day 6 - Thursday MARTINIQUE -DÉCOUVERTE EN 4X4 (1/2 day)*

Explore the most beautiful scenery in the whole of "Flower Island".

Your driver will take you on a stunning route, featuring rainforest, rivers and plantations. Your trip will end with a visit to a distillery.

Day 6 - Thursday ST PIERRE / MEMORIES OF TIMES GONE BY*

Walking tour of the town: discover its intriguing past and present. Then head to the Habitation Ceron, dating from the 18th century, for a guided tour of the land and the ruins of the former sugar and cassava refinery. Discover the magical outdoors, where you can see Albizia Saman, the rain tree, which won the tree of the year award in 2016.

Day 7 - Friday DESHAIES - BOTANIC GARDEN (1/2 day - morning)*

Don't miss the incredible Botanic Garden, based at the former home of the comedian Coluche. You can see a dazzling array of tropical flowers and plants, a breathtaking waterfall and cute little birds from the parrot family. Then we'll round off the trip with an aperitif.

Day 8 - Saturday SAINT MARTIN / PANORAMA OF ST MARTIN*

Take the chairlift for an easy and effortless ride up to the highest point of the Dutch part of Saint Martin and enjoy 360 degree panoramic views out over the Caribbean Sea

Day 8 - Saturday SAINT MARTIN (1/2 day - morning)

Ascend the highest peak to admire the Dutch side of Saint Martin as well as a 360 degree view over the island. Then get your adrenaline flowing with PANORAMA AND ZIPLINE the world's steepest zip line! It's a breathtaking descent that only the most adventurous will brave.

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Formalities

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
