

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# Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday SAINT-MARTIN	Magnificent coves, hills, long strips of sand separated by a few sea lagoons and no less than 74 nationalities rub shoulders on this island where a simple welcome sign marks the border between France and Holland. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.		
Day 2 - Sunday NEVIS	This tiny volcanic island, sister island to St Kitts, where the traditional sport of cricket remains a national game, is a fascinating world of hot water springs, archeological sites and forests inhabited by green monkies. AShip at anchor, water sports available, beach.		
Day 3 - Monday ANTIGUA	The jagged coast of this former British colony is studded with magnificent beaches. Its typical port, with lively pubs and inns, gives it reams of historic charm. Ship at anchor, water sports available, beach.		
Day 4 - Tuesday SAINT-BARTHLEMY	A mountainous island that has become a symbol of luxury. A fabulous blend of serenity and upscale tourism, with 17 beautiful beaches. Ship at anchor water sports available, beach.		
Day 5 - Wednesday SAINT-KITTS	Its elegant Georgian style houses are a reminder of the island's British past. Known as "the fertile land", its underwater life is as fabulous as the wonderfully lush landscapes. Ship docked, no water sports, beach.		
Day 6 - Thursday ANGUILLA	A long strip of amazingly white sand delicately posed on turquoise water. This miniature island attracts the VIPs of this world, who love its intimacy and discretion. Ship at anchor, water sports available, beach.		
Day 7 - Friday JOST VAN DYKE	This tiny, mountainous island belonging to the UK Virgin Islands, is reputed to be named after a Dutch pirate. It offers superb views of the dazzling blue sea and solitary islands. At anchor, beach and water sports.		
Day 8 - Saturday SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA	A restorative day at sea. Choose from the range of inviting possibilities on our remarkable sailing ship. Lounge on chaise longues, cool off in one of or two swimming pools, work out with a sea view in our Espace Fitness, find instant calm at the spa and enjoy the attentive company of our G.O <sup>®</sup> team and crew members.		
Day 9 - Sunday BAIE DE SAMANA	Waves of immigration and trade have come to Samana Bay over hundreds of years. Napoleon's troops seized the bay area in the 19th Century, later selling it to the USA. Well-preserved with an authentic historical feel, the bay boasts beaches, mountains and luxuriant plant life. Ship at anchor, no water sports.		
Day 10 - Monday SAINT DOMINGUE	Christopher Columbus discovered what was to become the capital of the New World. This historic city boasts beautiful colonial architecture and the famous Malecon promenade. Ship docked in port.		
Day 11 - Tuesday ÎLE CATALINA	The small island of Catalina, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is known for its coral reefs and pristine beaches rich in white sand. Its turquoise water make it easy to see coral, multicoloured fish and all the richness of this region. Private beach for the Caribbean Beach Club. Boats at anchor, no was sports.		
Day 12 - Wednesday LA ROMANA	A little port, built in 1851 to ease maritime traffic. The town was only officially founded in 1897. The city itself only began to grow 20 years later, when Italian immigrants built a large windmill for grinding sugar canes. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.		





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#### Excursions of your cruise

Day 2 - Sunday NEVIS / ISLAND HIGHLIGHTS AND BOTANICAL GARDEN*	Visit this charming island - known as the Queen of the Caribees - its historic sites and its 8 acre Botanical Gardens. This highly popular tour includes a visit to Hamilton House, birthplace of Alexander Hamilton, one of the USA's founding fathers. Your tour will also take in the Botanical Gardens, where you can admire one of the biggest and most diverse botanical collections in any tropical region.		
Day 2 - Sunday NEVIS / HIKING*	Enjoy a 2-hour hike to discover Nevis' lush greenery and natural heritage. You'll have the opportunity to walk through the Rainforest while appreciatin the island's flora and fauna. The tour ends on Pinney beach, where a swim will round off this beautiful morning's hiking.		
Day 3 - Monday ANTIGUA / SWIM WITH THE RAYS*	Adrenalin guaranteed for a rendez-vous with pastenague rays. After a 30-minute bus ride and a ride in a speedboat, you'll get to Stingray City for a super, safe, sensory experience. Even non-swimmers can see these strange and gracious creatures twirling through the shallow water.		
Day 3 - Monday ANTIGUA - BALADE DÉCOUVERTE EN 4*4*	The discovery of the island off the beaten track is done in all-terrain vehicles. You will leave the English countryside in the tropics with its authentical charming hamlets and its remains of old refineries attesting to the intense sugar activity before crossing the luxuriant tropical forest. You will not miss the swimming break on the magnificent Caribbean coast.		
Day 4 - Tuesday SAINT BARTH / CATAMARAN (1/2 day)*	Sail northwards around the coast of St Barths in a superb catamaran. You will get a chance to swim when you arrive at the Colombier Bay Nature Reserve.		
Day 5 - Wednesday SAINT KITTS / BEST OF ST KITTS*	Brimstone Hill fort rises some 250 metres above sea level. This "Gibralter of the West Indies" as it was called in the 17th century, is one of the best preserved forts in the Americas. You'll also see a batik demonstration by local craftsmen. English guide only.		
Day 5 - Wednesday SAINT KITTS / KITTITIAN HILL*	Escape for the day in a haven of peace, in the hills of St Kitts, to enjoy spectacular views from the infinity pool! Your 45-minute scenic drive will take you through picturesque villages, spectacular coastline and captivating scenery to the 5-star Kittitian Hill Hotel. You will taste three dishes compose mainly of ingredients from his own farm.		
Day 5 - Wednesday SAINT KITTS / A SPLASH OF ART & WINE*	Discover Shadwell Greathouse and its history dating back to the 1600s. You will be welcomed by Sasha, a young artist who will take you to her studing for a special art class. You will receive an apron, a full seat with your easel, your brushes, your canvas and most importantly, your painting and your wine! Day 9 - Sunday SAMANA BAY / LOS HAITISES NATURAL PARK (half day)*	Explore Los Haitises National Park. from the sea Navigate through this natural labyrinth of vertically-trained sugar cane in the bay which is the habi of numerous colonies of seabirds, before heading off to explore the mangrove forest. You will visit one of the park's caverns which bears traces of religious beliefs, left by the first Native American inhabitants of the Dominican Republic.		
Day 10 - Monday SANTO DOMINGO / SANTO DOMINGO*	Discover America's first capital aboard the Chuchu colonial train. Visit the MUSEO KAH KOW, where the hologram of Christopher Columbus will thow he introduced cocoa to the kings of Spain, and taste with your 5 senses the different cocoas produced by the finca Esmeralda, which produsement of the finest organic cocoa in the world. Their customers include LINDT and VALHRONA. Continue on to the MUSEO DEL RON DOMINICAN the Rum and Sugar Cane Museum, an interesting source of information on part of Dominican history and the various tools used over the centuring to extract the cane juice needed to make our famous rum. The museum captivates all visitors who enter the various rooms, going back in time to discover this ancient history. And, of course, finish off with a rum tasting!		
Day 12 - Wednesday LA ROMANA / CAVE OF WONDERS (1/2 day, morning)*	Explore the amazing 240 square metres of the Cave of Wonders. In the midst of stalactites, columns and other rock formations, you will discover ancient drawings left behind by the first indigenous people of the Caribbean. On your way back, you will stop off at La Romana where you can do a spot of shopping at the village market.		
Day 12 - Wednesday LA ROMANA / ONE DAY TO PUNTA CANA RESORT (1dav)*	Before your flight, enjoy a wonderful day at the Punta Cana Resort, relax on its magnificent coconut palm beach and enjoy the Dominican atmosphere. Day pass from 10.30am to 4pm. Return directly to the airport of Punta Cana.

#### **HEALTH FORMALITIES**

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
