

Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Wednesday LA ROMANA	A little port, built in 1851 to ease maritime traffic, the town was only officially founded in 1897. The city itself only began to grow 20 years later, when Italian immigrants built a large mill to grind the sugar cane. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.	
Day 2 - Thursday SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA	A restorative day at sea and hoose from the range of inviting possibilities on our remarkable sailing ship.	
Day 3 - Friday ANGUILLA	A long strip of amazingly white sand delicately posed on turquoise water. This miniature island attracts the VIPs of this world, who love its intimacy and discretion. Ship at anchor, water sports available, beach.	
Day 4 - Saturday JOST VAN DYKE	This tiny, mountainous island belonging to the UK Virgin Islands, is reputed to be named after a Dutch pirate. It offers superb views of the dazzling blue sea and solitary islands. At anchor, beach and water sports.	
Day 5 - Sunday PRICKLY PEAR / VIRGIN GORDA	Privatization of a beach on Prickly Pear Island for the Caribbean Beach Club day. Guests who have booked the "Virgin Gorda Panoramas" excursion will discover an amazing geological curiosity: large granite boulders softened by erosion, creating natural emerald pools lined with white sand. Boats at anchor, beach and water sports.	
Day 6 - Monday SAINT MARTIN	Magnificent coves, hills, long strips of sand separated by a few sea lagoons and no less than 74 nationalities rub shoulders on this island where a simple welcome sign marks the border between France and Holland. Boat docked, beach, dive locker closed.	
Day 7 - Tuesday SAINT-BARTHLEMY	A mountainous island that has become a symbol of luxury. A fabulous blend of serenity and upscale tourism, with 17 beautiful beaches. Ship at anchor, water sports available, beach.	
Day 8 - Wednesday ANTIGUA	The jagged coast of this former British colony is studded with magnificent beaches. Its typical port, with lively pubs and inns, gives it reams of historic charm. Ship at anchor, water sports available, beach.	
Day 9 - Thursday POINTE-Ã -PITRE	Spices, flowers, fish and fruit, the local markets abound with colour and exotic produce from this generous island paradise. Passengers boarding and disembarking at this port of call. Ship docked in port.

Excursions of your cruise


Day 3 - Friday ANGUILLA/BEACH CLUB (1/2 day)	Enjoy the most beautiful beach in Anguilla. Let yourself be seduced by its white sand and crystal clear blue water. Relax on sunbeds and enjoy the paradisiaque view!	
Day 5 - Sunday VIRGIN GORDA / PANORAMA*	The local open-top bus takes the crest route and allows you to enjoy stunning views. A geological surprise lies at the end of the path with strange and tempting granite formations, the "Bath". Natural bathtubs to try before heading to your Caribbean Beach. For information, only passengers who have booked the excursion will have the opportunity to visit Virgin Gorda and the Baths. Panoramic tour by open local bus and walking tour in the Baths. Swimming is prohibited in the event of a red flag.	
Day 6 - Monday SAINT MARTIN / PANORAMA OF ST MARTIN*	Take the chairlift for an easy and effortless ride up to the highest point of the Dutch part of Saint Martin and enjoy 360 degree panoramic views out over the Caribbean Sea.	
Day 6 - Monday SAINT MARTIN / PANORAMA AND ZIPLINE (1/2 day - morning)*	Ascend the highest peak to admire the Dutch side of Saint Martin as well as a 360 degree view over the island. Then get your adrenaline flowing with the world's steepest zip line! It's a breathtaking descent that only the most adventurous will brave.	
Day 7 - Tuesday SAINT BARTH / CATAMARAN (1/2 day)*	Sail northwards around the coast of St Barths in a superb catamaran. You will get a chance to swim when you arrive at the Colombier Bay Nature Reserve.	
Day 8 - Wednesday ANTIGUA / SWIM WITH THE RAYS*	Adrenalin guaranteed for a rendez-vous with pastenague rays. After a 30-minute bus ride and a ride in a speedboat, you'll get to Stingray City for a super, safe, sensory experience. Even non-swimmers can see these strange and gracious creatures twirling through the shallow water.	
Day 8 - Wednesday ANTIGUA - BALADE DÉCOUVERTE EN 4*4*	The discovery of the island off the beaten track is done in all-terrain vehicles. You will leave the English countryside in the tropics with its authentically charming hamlets and its remains of old refineries attesting to the intense sugar activity before crossing the luxuriant tropical forest. You will not miss the swimming break on the magnificent Caribbean coast.	
Day 9 - Thursday PTP / ONE DAY AT CLUB MED LA CARAVELLE (1day)*	Located on Grande-Terre, enjoy a fantastic day at Village La Caravelle, established for more than 30 years on one of the most beautiful beaches of fine golden sand in Guadeloupe. Return direcly to the airport. Day pass from 10am to 3pm.	
Day 9 - Thursday GUADALUPE / BASSE TERRE - THE MAMELLE PARK (1/2 day - morning)*	A superb excursion to discover the fauna and flora in the north of the island: you'll visit the Cascade aux Ecrevisses and walk in the Parc des Mamelles animal park where, if you have a head for heights, you can do the canopy tour.

Formalities

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.

Port of La Romana (Dominican Republic) - Cruise Terminal: Cruise Port Terminal East or Cruise Port "La Romana West". Punta Cana / La Romana airport transfer: 80 km approx. Transfer airport Santo Domingo / Port of La Romana: 100 km about 1h15.
