

Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Tuesday MARSEILLE	Founded in 600 BCE by Greek sailors from Phocaea, the Old Port and its historic neighbourhoods, the Byzantine-style Notre-Dame-de-la-Garde basilica, its sunny corniche facing the sea and its wild rocky inlets make it a city of great contrasts. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
Day 2 - Wednesday PORTOFINO	This stunning fishing village nestling in the bay in the shade of the pine trees is sheer perfection in pastel hues, and a haunt for the jet set. Ship at anchor. Water sports.
Day 3 - Thursday CANNES	The town owes its fame to an English lord who fell in love with this small fishing port in the 14th century. After the English aristocracy, Mérimée and Maupassant also succumbed to the discreet charm of this town which was soon to become one of the most famous in Europe. Boat at anchor, beach, closed nautical hall.

Day 2 - Wednesday
PORTOFINO / WALKING
TOLID IN DODTOFINO*

Accompanied by a guide, discover Portofino and his beautiful port , its story, and its monuments. Let the village walk you trough it secrets through a 2 hour stroll in this stunning area.

Day 2 - Wednesday PORTOFINO / CRUISE TO CAMOGLI

Enjoy a guided boat ride to the San Fruttuoso's bay - famous for 11th century abbey hidden in a small creek. Discover the picturesque fishing village of Camogli and all the high perched houses , painted in pastel colors. Visit the amazing church of Santa Maria Assunta (closed on mondays) and during your free time, walk through its narrow streets and along its small port. A village full of charms.

Day 3 - Thursday CANNES / GRASSE, A FRAGRANT BALCONY OVERLOOKING THE SEA (1/2 day)*

Let allow yourself to be driven by the captivating fragrances from the perfume factories of Grasse. Visit the perfume maker's laboratory, approach the different manufacturing processes and their secrets. Choose your own programme: be involved in a perfume workshop, discover the Provencal museum of Costume and Jewelry or stroll through the narrow streets of Grasse...

Day 4 - Friday MARSEILLE /AIX EN PROVENCE, HOMELAND OF CÉZANNE (1/2 day, morning)*

Let's go to Aix en Provence, former capital of Provence and homeland of the famous painter Paul Cézanne. Stroll along the Cours Mirabeau, built on the site of the medieval ramparts, admire the elegant facades of its mansions, explore the old Mazarin district and discover the magnificent Saint-Sauveur Cathedral with contrasting architectural styles. You will also enjoy some free time to shop or relax on the terrace of a café.

Day 4 - Friday MARSEILLE / CASSIS* Take the Route des Crêtes to reach this little fishing port, a genuine natural gem, nestled between two incredible sites: Cap Canaille and the famous Massif des Calanques. The imposing cliffs and the sea stretching out as far as the eye can see constitute the breathtaking scenery. You will discover the secret charm if this charming village by walking through the narrow alleys and squares lined with colourfoul fishermen's houses, a postcard landscape!

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport.

Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality

and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate

showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
