



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Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Wednesday MARSEILLE	Founded in 600 BCE by Greek sailors from Phocaea, the Old Port and its historic neighbourhoods, the Byzantine-style Notre-Dame-de-la-Garde basilica, its sunny corniche facing the sea and its wild rocky inlets make it a city of great contrasts. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.		
Day 2 - Thursday SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA	A restorative day at sea and hoose from the range of inviting possibilities on our remarkable sailing ship.		
Day 3 - Friday PORTOVENERE	This fishing village was an important maritime centre until the 15th century. Its old pastel-coloured houses clinging to the hillside and its narrow intertwining streets demonstrate that it has retained its authenticity. Ship at anchor, water sports.		
Day 4 - Saturday PORTOFINO	This stunning fishing village nestling in the bay in the shade of the pine trees is sheer perfection in pastel hues, and a haunt for the jet set. Ship at anchor. Water sports.		
Day 5 - Sunday SAINT-TROPEZ	The small village of St Tropez on France's Côte d'Azur has the highest concentration of celebrities in Europe, and succeeds in combining luxury and authenticity in a truly charming decor. Ship at anchor, water sports available, no direct access to a beach.


View on the old town of St Tropez and the lofty 16th-century Citadel & Sail close to the coast to discover celebrities houses! Return to the boat is at your discretion.

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Formalities

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality

and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate

showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
