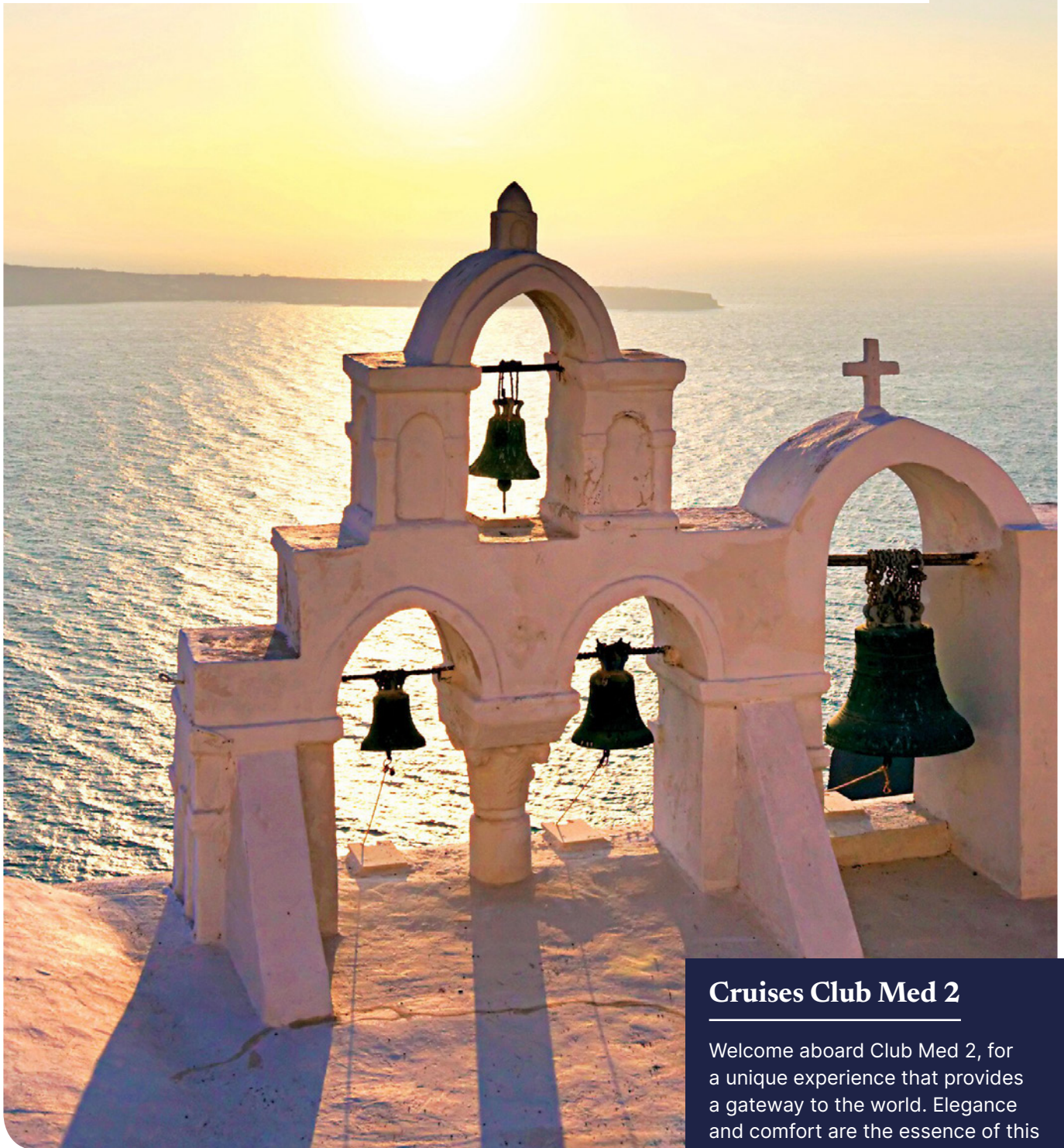

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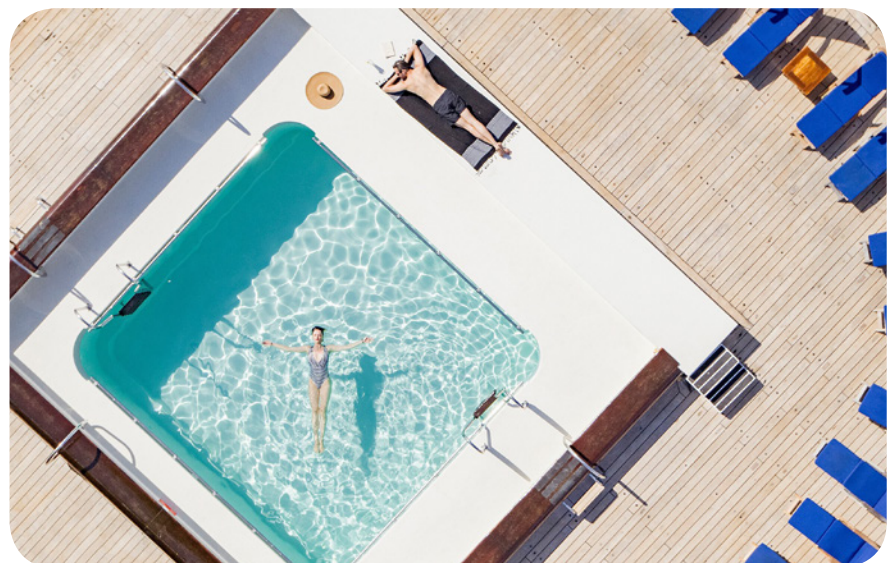

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Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday ATHENS/LAVRIO	The Greek capital opens the pages of its age-old history. In the heart of modernity, the Acropolis and the narrow streets of the Plaka district reveal their splendour and charm. Boat docked in Lavrio, no water sports and no direct access to a beach. Passengers boarding and disembarking at this port of call.
Day 2 - Sunday MONEMVASIA	Carved on a rock and nicknamed the "Gibraltar of the East", stroll through this medieval village with its vaulted streets and discover the exceptionally well-preserved Byzantine churches and Venetian mansions. Boat at anchor
Day 3 - Monday SANTORINI	A tragic eruption resulted in the formation of a deep blue bay, and white houses are dotted over the jagged rocky surface of this island that inspired the legend of Atlantis. Devastatingly beautiful. Ship docked, no water sports and no direct access to a beach.
Day 4 - Tuesday BODRUM	Our course is set for Bodrum and its meandering coastline. With picture-perfect house fronts, a medieval castle and calm waters, it really is a jewel in the Aegan's crown. Ship docked, no water sports.
Day 5 - Wednesday KOS	Hippocrates, the father of medicine, was born on this verdant island. Crystal-clear waters, pretty beaches and a peaceful atmosphere make it the highlight of the Dodecanese. Ship docked, no water sports.
Day 6 - Thursday PAROS	The sweetness of its orchards and its still authentic villages captivate the senses. Its white marble quarries have given life to remarkable statues dating back to antiquity and ensured its prosperity. Ship at anchor. Water sports.
Day 7 - Friday MILOS	This volcanic island with astonishing landscapes and pink, white and gold beaches is the home of the celebrated Venus. Ship at anchor. Water sports.
Day 8 - Saturday ATHENS/LAVRIO	The Greek capital opens the pages of its age-old history. In the heart of modernity, the Acropolis and the narrow streets of the Plaka district reveal their splendour and charm. Boat docked in Lavrio, no water sports and no direct access to a beach. 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Excursions of your cruise

Day 2 - Sunday MONEMVASIA - TASTING TOUR*	en cours
Day 3 - Monday SANTORINI - AKROTERI OIA (1/2 day, morning)*	After sailing past the caldera, you'll begin by visiting Akroteri, a bronze age town that was buried by the volcanic eruption in 1530 BC. Miraculously protected since the cataclysm by a thick coat of impermeable pumice stone, you can admire the narrow streets and paved squares, the partially-conserved houses with their windows, doors and stairways. This was Cycladic civilisation at its peak. You'll then travel through the island with its fine landscapes and stop at the picturesque village of Oia (or Ia). You'll have free time to stroll in the narrow streets with their blue and white houses. You'll walk back to Thira where you'll reach the cable car via the panoramic seafront street. Please note that cable car is always crowded.
Day 3 - Monday SANTORINI - KAMENI ISLAND (1/2 day, afternoon)*	By boat, discover the island's famous caldera on Nea Kameni. A 30-minute walk takes you to the top of the island where you can observe the volcanic rock formations. You'll then be taken by boat to the thermal springs where you can swim in the warm water.
Day 4 - Tuesday BODRUM / GULET SAILING BOAT CRUISE (1 day)*	Join a small group and climb aboard a gulet - a traditional Turkish wooden sailing boat - and sail across the stunning coves of the Bodrum Peninsula. You can marvel at the isolated coasts with exotic names, enjoy a delicious local lunch and even swim in some of the beautiful bays with crystal clear waters.
Day 4 - Tuesday BODRUM / HISTORIC BODRUM (1/2 day)*	Your guide will take you by bus to explore Bodrum Castle, built by the Knights of St John. The castle offers you the chance to see the cargo of a Syrian merchant ship from the 13th century BCE and the beautiful golden tiara of a Carian princess. You will stop off at the site of the Mausoleum of Halicarnassus, one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. You will also be able to explore the ancient amphitheatre overlooking the magnificent bay of Bodrum.
Day 5 - Wednesday KOS / ASKLEPIEION (1/2 day, morning)*	The Asclepeion of Kos: a sacred place of healing on a green hillside with spectacular views where you will learn about the Asclepeion, one of the most important archaeological sites of Greece. A genuine religious centre dedicated to healing, it included, among other things, infirmaries, temples, hot springs, hotels and a medical school. After your visit, you will travel to the traditional village of Zia on Mount Dikaios, and take in the panoramic view of the entire island. You will end your walk with a visit to the Tree of Hippocrates, under which he would have taught medicine.
Day 6 - Thursday PAROS / ISLAND TOUR*	On this island tour, you will discover the two key towns on Paros: Naoussa and Parikia. Naoussa is a little fishing port filled with charming narrow streets, nestled in the middle of a dramatic bay. In Parikia, the island's capital, the winding streets and bright white buildings will soon have you under their spell. The stunning Byzantine Panagia Katapoliani, or the Church of a Hundred Doors, is a miniature Hagia Sophia, built in the 6th century.
Day 7 - Friday MILOS - THE MANY FACES OF MILOS (1/2 day)*	Milos is the cradle of the history of the Cyclades since prehistoric times. This sightseeing tour will give you a chance to explore the beautiful scenery of this charming island with its lunar landscapes. It will take you to Plaka where you can see the stunning traditional architecture. You will see the marble Roman amphitheatre and the site where one of the most famous statues in the world once stood: The Venus de Milo. You can cool off after your sightseeing trip with a swim on Sarakinko Beach against an amazing backdrop (don't forget your swimsuit and beach towel).
Day 8 - Saturday ATHENS/LAVRIO - ACROPOLIS MUSEUM (1/2 day, morning)*	before your departure, we will offer you the chance to take an amazing tour of the latest discoveries made below the Acropolis Museum. You will be able to explore the remains of the private buildings, narrow streets and public places that made up this great city in ancient times, below the modern city of Athens Next, you will see major pieces from the Golden Age of Athens, including the Caryatids and the Parthenon Frieze. Transfer back to the airport or CM2 depending of the flight tickets.

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Formalities

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
