

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Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

Day 3 - Monday CALVI	From its commanding position dominating the ocean, Calvi keeps a faithful watch over the wild coastline and mountain backdrop. A white sand bea and shady palm trees welcome visitors to the island. Ship at anchor, water sports available, no direct access to a beach.

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Excursions of your cruise

Day 2 - Sunday PORTOFINO / WALKING TOUR IN PORTOFINO*	Accompanied by a guide, discover Portofino and his beautiful port, its story, and its monuments. Let the village walk you trough it secrets through a 2 hour stroll in this stunning area.		
Day 2 - Sunday PORTOFINO / CRUISE TO CAMOGLI	Enjoy a guided boat ride to the San Fruttuoso's bay - famous for 11th century abbey hidden in a small creek. Discover the picturesque fishing village of Camogli and all the high perched houses, painted in pastel colors. Visit the amazing church of Santa Maria Assunta (closed on mondays) and during your free time, walk through its narrow streets and along its small port. A village full of charms.		
Day 3 - Monday CALVI / U GIUSSANI : ALONG THE MOUNTAIN RIDGE IN A 4X4 (1/2 day)*	With this Ideal short excursion, discover one of the most beautiful panorama in Corsica. And admire, at an altitude of 1200 m, the breathtaking 360 degree view over the north of the island. From the Cap Corse to the Revellata peninsula, contemplate the Corsican panorama, not forgetting the highest summit of the Balagne area, the Monte Padru. Your adventure will continue through the centenarian olive-trees in the Reginu valley.		
Day 3 - Monday CALVI - BALAGNE VILLAGES (1/2 day, morning)*	Some of Corsica's most beautiful villages blend beautifully into the landscape of La Balagne. You'll take the scenic route, with superb views of the plain, the sea, the Bay of Calvi and the lle Rousse. You'll discover the maquis, with its fabulous fragrance and vegetation, and the mediaeval village of Sant'Antonino, the island's most ancient village, perched up high on the rocks, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy a cool glass of Muscat.		
Day 3 - Monday CALVI / JET SKI HIKE (1 hour, morning)*	Go for an hour on a jet ski tour to discover Corsica's wild coast. The price includes 1 jet ski for 1 or 2 people (no boat permit required), the supervision by a qualified guide, tour schedule will be confirmed on board. Activity not recommended for people suffering from back, joint and muscle problems.		
Day 3 - Monday CALVI / MOUNTAIN BIKE OUTING (1/2 day)*	Discover the secret paths that will lead you to the cultural, heritage and historical riches of this beautiful region. (electrically assisted bicycle)		
Day 3 - Monday CALVI - THE BAY OF CALVI BY SPEEDBOAT (1h)*	Leaving from the port of Calvi you will admire both the fine sandy beach which borders the town and the mountains and their eternal snow, then you will head towards the tip of Revellata. Of incomparable beauty, this peninsula with unspoiled nature will offer you a succession of wild coves between turquoise waters, maquis and sculpted cliffs.		
Day 3 - Monday CALVI -SCANDOLA RESERVE BY BOAT*	Accompanied by your captain, you will sail towards the famous Scandola nature reserve. Fully protected as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, this maritime and terrestrial reserve will enchant you with its volcanic rocks in red, ocher and black tones, its rhyolite organs, its steep cliffs, its endemic fauna and flora. You will be immersed in the heart of the wild nature installed aboard one of our boats designed for 12 people, combining comfort and conviviality.

GARDEN*

You will walk through the alleys of the small medieval village of Eze to discover all the hidden charm. You will then visit the exotic garden that fills the ruins of the medieval castle and contemplate the most beautiful view of the Côte d'Azur and the Bay of Beaulieu in particular.



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Formalities

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport.

Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality

and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate

showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
