



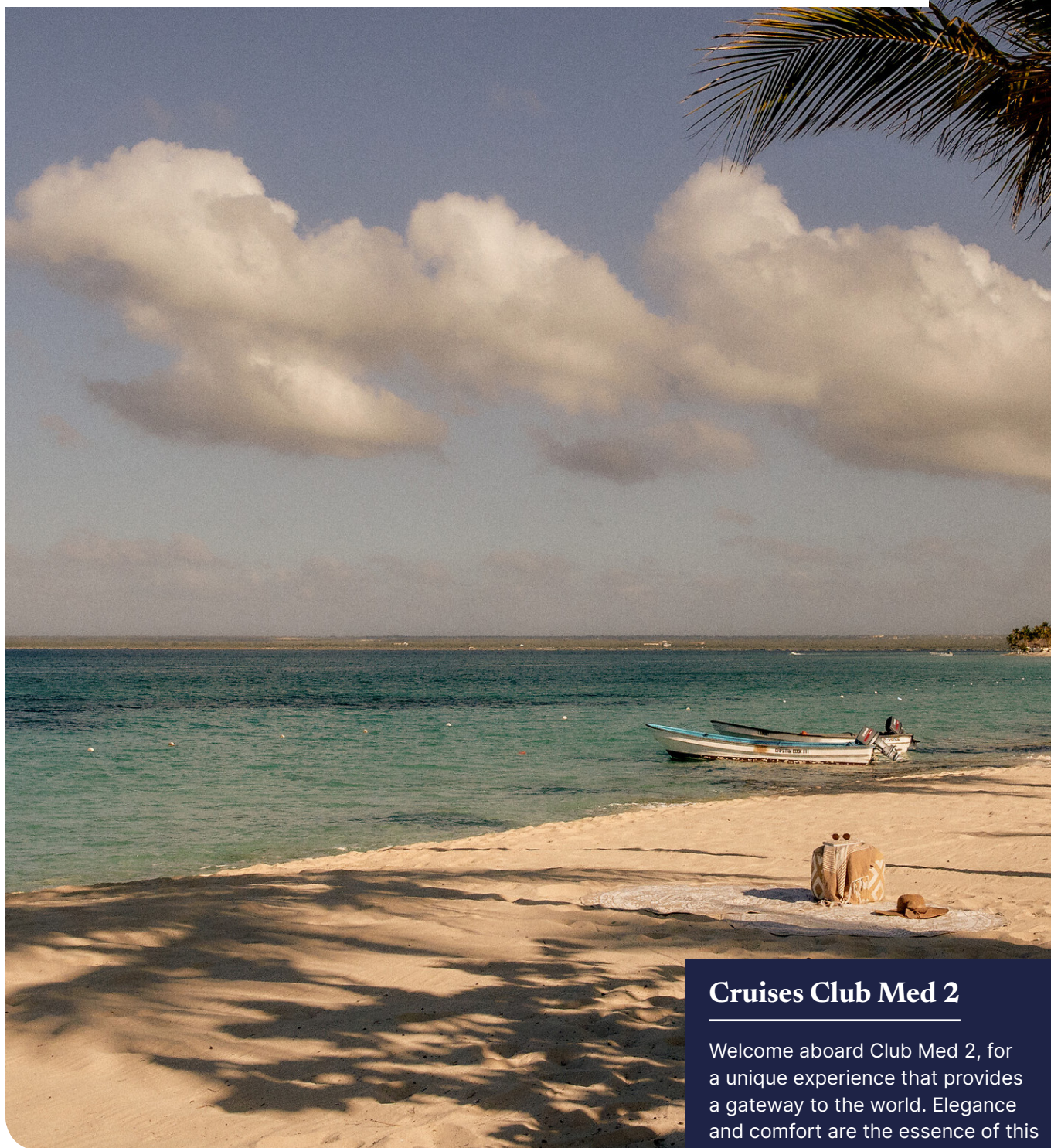

Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Monday FORT-DE-FRANCE	The largest of the French West Indian towns blends cosmopolitan style and local colour, with its urban lifestyle, colourful markets, metal architecture and charming old houses. Stopover for boarding and disembarking. Ship docked in port.
Day 2 - Tuesday DOMINICA	This lush volcanic island, home to the last Caribbean Indians, has almost as many rivers as there are days in the year. Mother Nature reigns supreme. At anchor. Water sports, no beach.
Day 3 - Wednesday DESHAIES	On the most lush side of the Ile Papillon, Deshaies is a perfect example of the simple charms of Creole life. Time stands still in these tranquil fishing villages surrounded by gentle green hills. At anchor. Beach and water sports.
Day 4 - Thursday SAINT-BARTHELEMY	A mountainous island that has become a symbol of luxury. A fabulous blend of serenity and upscale tourism, with 17 beautiful beaches. Ship at anchor, water sports available, beach.
Day 5 - Friday SAINT MARTIN	Magnificent coves, hills, long strips of sand separated by a few sea lagoons and no less than 74 nationalities rub shoulders on this island where a simple welcome sign marks the border between France and Holland. Boat docked, beach, dive locker closed.
Day 6 - Saturday PRICKLY PEAR / VIRGIN GORDA	Privatization of a beach on Prickly Pear Island for the Caribbean Beach Club day. Guests who have booked the "Virgin Gorda Panoramas" excursion will discover an amazing geological curiosity: large granite boulders softened by erosion, creating natural emerald pools lined with white sand. Boats at anchor, beach and water sports.
Day 7 - Sunday ANTIGUA	The jagged coast of this former British colony is studded with magnificent beaches. Its typical port, with lively pubs and inns, gives it reams of historic charm. Ship at anchor, water sports available, beach.
Day 8 - Monday POINTE-À-PITRE	Spices, flowers, fish and fruit, the local markets abound with colour and exotic produce from this generous island paradise. Passengers boarding and disembarking at this port of call. Ship docked in port.

Excursions of your cruise

Day 2 - Tuesday ROSEAU/ UNUSUAL SWIMS IN DOMINICA (1/2 day)*	Travel to the untamed summits of the island, and after a short walk you will come to a natural rock pool and narrow canyon fed by a waterfall where you can swim surrounded by nature. (Undeveloped natural site). Continue to the village of Wotten Waven, also known as the Wellness Village for its therapeutic pools fed by hot sulphur water. Be sure to take a soothing bath in the midst of fumaroles and porous volcanic rocks.
Day 2 - Tuesday ROSEAU/ NATURAL WONDERS OF DOMINICA (1/2 day)*	Come and enjoy the most popular natural attractions that Dominica has to offer! Spanny Falls are still a bit of a secret, even though they are the height of a 7-story building. Continue on to the Trois Pitons National Park, and cross the forest to the Emerald Pool and its 12-metre waterfall where you can cool off (undeveloped area). You will finally make your way to the village of Trafalgar to the viewing platform to see the majestic waterfalls that the village is famous for before returning to the boat.
Day 3 - Wednesday DESHAIES - BOTANIC GARDEN*	Don't miss the incredible Botanic Garden, based at the former home of the comedian Coluche. You can see a dazzling array of tropical flowers and plants, a breathtaking waterfall and cute little birds from the parrot family. Then we'll round off the trip with an aperitif.
Day 4 - Thursday SAINT BARTH / CATAMARAN (1/2 day)*	Sail north along the stunning coast of St. Barths aboard a luxurious catamaran. Upon reaching the pristine Colombier Bay Nature Reserve, take the opportunity to swim in its crystal-clear waters for an unforgettable experience.
Day 5 - Friday SAINT MARTIN / PANORAMA OF ST MARTIN (1/2 day)*	Take the chairlift for an easy and effortless ride up to the highest point of the Dutch part of Saint Martin and enjoy 360 degree panoramic views out over the Caribbean Sea.
Day 7 - Sunday ANTIGUA - BALADE DÉCOUVERTE EN 4*4*	The discovery of the island off the beaten track is done in all-terrain vehicles. You will leave the English countryside in the tropics with its authentically charming hamlets and its remains of old refineries attesting to the intense sugar activity before crossing the luxuriant tropical forest. You will not miss the swimming break on the magnificent Caribbean coast.
Day 7 - Sunday ANTIGUA - EMERALD CRUISE*	Set sail on a stylish catamaran and cruise along the island's picturesque coastline to discover one of its stunning beaches. Enjoy some free time to swim in the crystal-clear waters or unwind on the soft white sand. Then, hop back on board for a scenic ride to another idyllic beach on the island's western shore, where you'll anchor for more swimming and sunbathing. A delicious lobster lunch will be served, perfectly paired with a glass of sparkling wine. To top it all off, an open bar awaits on the return journey—everything you need for a perfect, carefree day at sea.
Day 8 - Monday GUADALUPE/ BASSE TERRE - THE MAMELLE PARK (1/2 day - morning)*	A superb excursion to discover the fauna and flora in the north of the island: you'll visit the Cascade aux Ecrevisses and walk in the Parc des Mamelles animal park where, if you have a head for heights, you can do the canopy tour.
Day 8 - Monday PTP / ONE DAY AT CLUB MED LA CARAVELLE (1day)*	Located on Grande-Terre, enjoy a fantastic day at Village La Caravelle, established for more than 30 years on one of the most beautiful beaches of fine golden sand in Guadeloupe. Return directly to the airport. Day pass from 10am to 3pm.

Formalities

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
