



Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday ATHENS	The Greek capital opens the pages of its age-old history. In the heart of modernity, the Acropolis and the narrow streets of the Plaka district reveal their splendour and charm. Ship docked. Passengers may board and disembark here.
Day 2 - Sunday NAUPLIA	The original capital of modern day Greece is a charming city that combines Neoclassical and Ottoman influences. Can be admired from the citadel and from the Venitian fort. Ship at anchor. Water sports.
Day 3 - Monday PAROS	The sweetness of its orchards and its still authentic villages captivate the senses. Its white marble quarries have given life to remarkable statues dating back to antiquity and ensured its prosperity. Ship at anchor. Water sports.
Day 4 - Tuesday DELOS & MYKONOS	Morning in Delos at anchor. The birthplace of Apollo and Artemis, with an archaeological site that is one of the most important in Greece. Short voyage to Mykonos in the middle of the day. The smallest island in the Cyclades owes its popularity to its row of windmills, its immaculate monasteries and its secret beaches. Late port of call. Ship at anchor, no water sports.
Day 5 - Wednesday PATMOS	The Monastery of Saint John the Theologian, founded in 1088, is the most famous sight on Patmos. This island paradise also has long sandy beaches and picturesque villages, with houses in the traditional Dodecanese style. Ship at anchor, water sports available.
Day 6 - Thursday KUSADASI	It is the cultural stopover par excellence to visit Ephesus. Its 24,000-seat theatre prefigures the size of the city and its artistic and intellectual influence in the ancient world. Boat at quay, no water sports.
Day 7 - Friday ÇESME	Throughout its history, the town has been home to many civilisations and cultures. The Lydians, the Persians, the Kingdom of Pergamum, the Roman State, the Byzantine and Ottoman Empires all ruled over the town in their turn. Its fascinating history stems from its multicultural past. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
Day 8 - Saturday BODRUM	Our course is set for Bodrum and its meandering coastline. With picture-perfect house fronts, a medieval castle and calm waters, it really is a jewel in the Aegan's crown. Ship docked, no water sports. Passengers may board and disembark here.

Formalities

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
