YOUR ITINERARY



DAY 1 - SATURDAY 8 AUGUST

BODRUM

Our course is set for Bodrum and its meandering coastline. With picture-perfect house fronts, a medieval castle and calm waters, it really is a jewel in the Aegan's crown. Ship docked, no water sports. Passengers may board and disembark here.

DAY 3 - MONDAY 10 AUGUST

AGIOS NIKOLAOS

This pretty little town has an enigmatic natural feature at its heart. As the town has grown around the lake, so have the legends and stories about this unusual body of water. It forms the perfect backdrop for a drink on the terrace of one of the many cafes. Boats at anchor, no water sports.

DAY 2 - SUNDAY 9 AUGUST

RHODES

While it's the Colosseum that has made Rhodes famous, the jasmine-scented streets have much more to offer. Wander in the footsteps of the Knights of St John, explore the UNESCO World Heritage Site of the medieval city, or simply soak up the easygoing Rhodes way of life. Ship docked, no water sports and no direct access to a beach.

DAY 4 - TUESDAY 11 AUGUST

CHANIA

The "Diamond of Crete" is an intertwining of architectures, as many testimonies of its long history. Its pristine and jagged shores sculpt bays and coves. Boats at anchor, water sports.

DAY 5 - WEDNESDAY 12 AUGUST

CYTHERA

The birthplace of Aphrodite, who has inspired so many painters and poets, is a place to let the imagination wander. Its isolation at the foot of the Peloponnese offers a quiet refuge of rocky coves and deserted beaches. Boat at anchor, beach and water sports available.

DAY 7 - FRIDAY 14 AUGUST

ZANTE

The long sandy beaches, the marine wildlife sanctuaries and the fertile hinterland of Zakynthos, covered with olive groves, vineyards and orchards, have plenty of surprises in store for the visitor. Ship at anchor. Water sports.

DAY 6 - THURSDAY 13 AUGUST

GYTHEON

Located at the southern tip of the Peloponnese, this small seaside town is reflected in the clear waters of the Mediterranean. A small, intimate and colourful port, Gytheon offers a variety of seafood specialities to be enjoyed by the water's edge. Boat at anchor.

DAY 8 - SATURDAY 15 AUGUST

CORFU

A coveted location at the gateway to the Adriatic, beautifully green mountains with creeks of white sand and a Venitian-style fortified town give it its own quite unique identity. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

YOUR EXCURSIONS

DAY 2 - SUNDAY 9 AUGUST

RHODES / THE BUTTERFLY VALLEY AND KAMIROS (1/2 DAY)*

Docked until 18:00

This panoramic coach tour takes in the new city of Rhodes, Mandraki port and the Agios Stefanos hill, offering a beautiful view over the city. Then you'll follow the coast to the ancient city of Kameiros, built on the side of a hill in the time of the Ancient Greeks. Next, the coast road will take you to the Valley of the Butterflies. This gorgeous forested valley has a calm, cool microclimate. Euplagia quadripunctaria butterflies live in the fresh air of the valley from May to September.

DAY 2 - SUNDAY 9 AUGUST

RHODES / THE SPLENDOUR OF RHODES (1 DAY)*

Docked until 18:00

Discover the Island of Roses, and two of its gems: Rhodes and Lindos! A panoramic tour will take you up to Mount Smith, with the remains of an ancient acropolis and a superb view over the sea and the old town. You'll then travel along the eastern coast of the island to the charming village of Lindos, where you'll visit the acropolis, an ancient fortress of the Knights of St John from which there is a stunning view. You'll be charmed by the little white streets and craft shops, and after lunch you'll walk round the Mediaeval city. You'll walk through the famous cobbled Street of the Knights, lined with 15th and 16th century Gothic "inns". You'll visit the 14th century Palace of the Grand Masters of the Knights of Rhodes, after which you'll have free time to visit the town centre before going back to the ship.

DAY 3 - MONDAY 10 AUGUST

AGIOS NICOLAOS - SAIL IN SPINA LONGA*

Docked until 18:00

Sail across the turquoise waters of Crete to the iconic island of Spinalonga. Once highly sought after for its strategic position, it guarded the entrance to the port of Elounda. Explore this fascinating site and uncover its rich history through impressive fortifications and remains left by Byzantine, Venetian, Ottoman, and Greek civilizations over the centuries.

Steeped in history and emotion, the island also served as a leper colony from 1904 to 1957, a poignant chapter brought to light in Victoria Hislop's novel "The Island."

Your experience concludes with a delightful tasting of local mezzé, offering a true taste of Cretan hospitality.

DAY 4 - TUESDAY 11 AUGUST

LA CANÉE (CHANIA) / AKROTIRI AND ITS MONASTERIES (1/2 DAY)*

Docked until 18:00

Come and discover the picturesque region of West Crete; first, you'll visit the heights of the Akrotiri peninsula, home to the Venizelos family's final resting place and a wonderful view of Chania. You will then visit the Chrysopigi Monastery, built in the 16th century and which houses remarkable religious treasures. Finally you will visit the monastery of Haghia Triada, founded in the 17th century, with its Renaissance church, and where you can try their local products.

YOUR EXCURSIONS

DAY 6 - THURSDAY 13 AUGUST

GYTHEON - MISTRA (1/2 DAY)*

Docked until 18:00

Occupying an exceptional site on the steep slope of a spur of the Taygetus Mountains, Mystras overlooks Sparta and the Eurotas valley.

Its churches, palaces, Byzantine monasteries adorned with superb frescoes, and its ruined houses bear witness to the splendor of the former capital of the Despotate of Morea.

At the top of a 621-meter-high peak stood a powerful fortress built in 1249, which was never conquered.

Transfer by bus (1 hour) followed by a walking tour – comfortable walking shoes are essential. Knees and shoulders must be covered.

DAY 6 - THURSDAY 13 AUGUST

GYTHEON - THE CAVES OF DIROS (1/2 DAY)*

Docked until 18:00

At the southernmost tip of the Peloponnese, Mani is a remote region that forms a rocky promontory between the Gulfs of Messenia and Laconia. On the western coast, the Caves of Diros are one of Greece's most spectacular natural features, Glifada being the most famous of the caves. A boat will take you on a ride along a subterranean river to admire stalactites, stalagmites and some fabulous crystals. On the way back, the bus will stop at Areopolis where you'll have free time to visit the town with its architecture typical of the Mani Peninsula, its towers, churches and little shops.

DAY 7 - FRIDAY 14 AUGUST

ZANTE - BLUE CAVES*

Docked until 18:00

Experience the magic of the Blue Caves on an unforgettable morning excursion in Zakynthos! Depart by coach to the charming port of Agios Nikolaos, then board a boat to explore a stunning series of sea caves. Marvel at the dazzling blue reflections that give the caves their name. Enjoy a unique swim stop in crystal-clear waters—directly from the boat. Return to Zante port by bus.

YOUR EXCURSIONS

DAY 8 - SATURDAY 15 AUGUST

CORFU / LES JARDIN D'ACHILLEION*

Start your day approximately 10 km south of the city with a visit to the Achilleion Palace. Built at the request of Empress Elisabeth of Austria (Sissi), this site is a tribute to Greek mythology.

Stroll through its terraced gardens, which offer superb views over the Ionian Sea.

Continue on to the Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where the visit is conducted entirely on foot in order to fully experience its unique atmosphere.

Please note: The villa is currently closed to visitors due to renovation works; only the gardens are open.

The morning excursion runs from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm, with a direct transfer to the airport at the end.

The afternoon excursion runs from 3:30 pm to 7:00 pm.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

To make the most of your cruise with complete peace of mind, here is some information to keep in mind.



CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and

may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return. We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence. Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
