| Day 1 - Thursday MARSEILLE | Founded in 600 BCE by Greek sailors from Phocaea, the Old Port and its historic neighbourhoods, the Byzantine-style Notre-Dame-de-la-Garde basilica, its sunny corniche facing the sea and its wild rocky inlets make it a city of great contrasts. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call. | | |

| Day 2 - Friday ROSES | The Catalan citadel is an ancient Greek colony founded in the 4th century BC by settlers from Marseille, and sits in a picturesque bay that is home t 16th-century fortifications and megalithic tombs. Boat at dock, nautical hall closed. | | |
| Day 3 - Saturday MAHÓN | Menorca's port invites you in to discover the unspoilt charms of the "blue and white island". Its cliffs and inlets hide reminders of megalithic times: navetes, taulas, and talaiots. Ship docked, no water sports and no direct access to a beach. | | |
| Day 4 - Sunday PALMA DE MALLORCA | Dominated by its imposing cathedral, considered to be one of the most beautiful Gothic structures in Spain, the capital of the Balearic Islands has a twin identity, combining modernism and traditions. Ship docked, no water sports. | | |
| Day 5 - Monday VALENCE | Covering 2,000 m², the gothic architecture of the Lonja de la Seda (Silk Exchange) has Unesco World Heritage status. It faces the Mercado Centra one of the most beautiful covered markets in Europe. Ship docked, no water sports and no direct access to a beach. | | |
| Day 6 - Tuesday ALICANTE | The Greeks called it the white citadel and the Romans the city of light. Closely linked, the old town, the port and the beach make this a city with i face turned resolutely towards the sea. Ship docked, no water sports, beach. | | |
| Day 7 - Wednesday ALMERIA | Built against the foothills of an arid deserted sierra, the city faces out onto an azure sea. Dominated by one of the most beautiful fortresses in Andalusia, it is also home to a stunning cathedral. Ship docked, no water sports. | | |
| Day 8 - Thursday MALAGA | Cosmopolitan Andalusia has 300 days of sunshine a year. It's also a major landmark in the history of Cubism - you can visit the house where Picass was born and the museum with over 200 of his works. Ship docked in port. Boarding and disembarkation port of call. | | |



CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport.

Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality

and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate

showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
