<b>Day 1 - Monday</b> NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
<b>Day 2 - Tuesday</b> PORTOVENERE	This fishing village was an important maritime centre until the 15th century. Its old pastel-coloured houses clinging to the hillside and its narrow intertwining streets demonstrate that it has retained its authenticity. Ship at anchor, water sports.
<b>Day 3 - Wednesday</b> ELBE	France and Italy vied for possession of this island, where Napoleon lived out his years of exile before it went back to Italy in 1860. Today it lives in peace, with national park status. Ship at anchor, water sports available, no direct access to a beach.
<b>Day 4 - Thursday</b> NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

## Excursions of your cruise

<p><b>Day 1 - Monday</b> NICE / MEDIEVAL EZE AND ITS EXOTIC GARDEN*</p>	<p>After admiring the wonderful landscapes of the Riviera through the middle cornice, you will visit one of the most picturesque perched villages in the region. You will walk through the alleys of the small medieval village of Eze to discover all the hidden charm. You will then visit the exotic garden that fills the ruins of the medieval castle and contemplate the most beautiful view of the Côte d'Azur and the Bay of Beaulieu in particular.</p>
<p><b>Day 2 - Tuesday</b> PORTOVENERE / DISCOVERY OF PORTOVENERE (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Start your tour on foot by passing through the ancient arch to Caruggio Portovenere. This unique little village on the Ligurian coast is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You will be able to enjoy the amazing view of Andrea Doria Castle with its imposing structure, before heading back towards the port, taking in the panoramic view over the town and the three islands. Your guided tour ends with a tasting of the delicious local wine and some of the local products that have made the region famous for its gastronomy.</p>
<p><b>Day 2 - Tuesday</b> PORTOVENERE / CAP SUR LES CINQUE TERRE*</p>	<p>Clinging to the Ligurian cliffs are five villages - Monterosso, Vernazza, Corniglia, Manarola and Riomaggiore. Marvel as you approach this magnificent coast with its villages suspended above the sea. As you disembark by local ferry boat, you will discover the beautiful village of Monterosso. 3 hours excursion. Allow 1 hour of navigation to reach the villages. (this excursion depends on weather and sea conditions)</p>
<p><b>Day 3 - Wednesday</b> ELBA / IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF NAPOLEON (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Visit Villa San Martino or Dei Mulini, where Napoleon spent his ten months of exile on the island of Elba, before exploring the pretty fishing port and fort in the little village of Porto Azzuro. On the road towards Portoferraio, stop for a wine tasting at the La Chiusa wine estate. You'll find that wine tastes even better when you're standing amidst the vines with the sea in the distance.</p>
<p><b>Day 3 - Wednesday</b> ELBE / URBAN TREKKING IN PORTOFERRAIO (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Set off on a guided fitness walk and take on the inclines. You'll be rewarded with a splendid view of the town and the private beaches that can be seen only from the summit. This walk will take you to Fort Falcone, where refreshments will be provided.</p>

## Formalities

### CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

### HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
