





Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
Day 2 - Sunday CALVI	From its commanding position dominating the ocean, Calvi keeps a faithful watch over the wild coastline and mountain backdrop. A white sand beach and shady palm trees welcome visitors to the island. Ship at anchor. Water sports.
Day 3 - Monday BONIFACIO	The tall, slender houses of the fortified town flirt with the steep chalk cliffs. Down below, one of the best harbours of the Mediterranean. Ship at anchor. Water sports.
Day 4 - Tuesday PONZA	Whether for Circe the goddess of magic or for the sheer beauty of the island, Ulysees spent a full year here. This large volcanic rock poised on divine waters has a wild and intimate nature. Ship at anchor, water sports available, no direct access to a beach.
Day 5 - Wednesday NAPLES	One of the finest bays in the world, dominated by Vesuvius, an emblem of romanticism. The city centre is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Ship docked.
Day 6 - Thursday CIVITAVECCHIA/ROME	Located just outside Rome, the coast was originally edged with luxurious villas built by the emperors Tiberius and Marcus-Aurelius. You will transfer by bus from the port of Latium to the Eternal City, where you will be free to explore the wonders of the Italian capital at your own pace. Boat docked, dive locker closed, stopover without beach.
Day 7 - Friday ELBE	France and Italy vied for possession of this island, where Napoleon lived out his years of exile before it went back to Italy in 1860. Today it lives in peace, with national park status. Ship at anchor, water sports available, no direct access to a beach.
Day 8 - Saturday NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

Excursions of your cruise

<p>Day 1 - Saturday NICE / MEDIEVAL EZE AND ITS EXOTIC GARDEN*</p>	<p>After admiring the wonderful landscapes of the Riviera through the middle cornice, you will visit one of the most picturesque perched villages in the region. You will walk through the alleys of the small medieval village of Eze to discover all the hidden charm. You will then visit the exotic garden that fills the ruins of the medieval castle and contemplate the most beautiful view of the Côte d'Azur and the Bay of Beaulieu in particular.</p>
<p>Day 2 - Sunday CALVI / MOUNTAIN BIKE OUTING (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Set off on an unforgettable adventure! Ride along secret paths and uncover the cultural, historical, and scenic gems of this beautiful region — all with the ease of an electric mountain bike. Not recommended for people with back pain or pregnant women. Departure and return from Calvi Port • Guided by a qualified bilingual instructor</p>
<p>Day 2 - Sunday CALVI / U GIUSSANI : ALONG THE MOUNTAIN RIDGE IN A 4X4 (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>With this Ideal short excursion, discover one of the most beautiful panorama in Corsica. And admire, at an altitude of 1200 m, the breathtaking 360 degree view over the north of the island. From the Cap Corse to the Revellata peninsula, contemplate the Corsican panorama, not forgetting the highest summit of the Balagne area, the Monte Padru. Your adventure will continue through the centenarian olive-trees in the Reginu valley.</p>
<p>Day 2 - Sunday CALVI - BALAGNE VILLAGES (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Some of Corsica's most beautiful villages blend beautifully into the landscape of La Balagne. You'll take the scenic route, with superb views of the plain, the sea, the Bay of Calvi and the Ile Rousse. You'll discover the maquis, with its fabulous fragrance and vegetation, and the mediaeval village of Sant'Antonino, the island's most ancient village, perched up high on the rocks, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy a cool glass of Muscat.</p>
<p>Day 3 - Monday BONIFACIO / CAVES AND CLIFFS (1/2 day, morning)*</p>	<p>In February 1996, the cliffs of Bonifacio were declared French National Heritage. Follow us and discover caves, cliffs and creeks, during a one hour guided boat ride. After the ride, visit Bonifacio by yourself and individual return to Club Med 2.</p>
<p>Day 3 - Monday BONIFACIO / LAVEZZI ISLANDS (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>The Lavezzi islands have got a hundred islands and are part of the Natural Reserve of "Bouches de Bonifacio" established in 1999. This small paradise of crystal clear water and sandy creeks presents a lunarlike landscape. You will have an hour of free time to swim and stroll along the flowery paths of its main island. No bar on the island; don't forget your bottle of water.</p>
<p>Day 5 - Wednesday NAPLES - HERCULANUM (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Despite its lack of facilities, the city of Herculaneum attracted rich people from Campania and Rome thanks to its location and amazing views over the Bay of Naples. Life there stopped in AD 79 following the eruption of Vesuvius which covered the city in a layer of ash. Here, you can see the public buildings such as the baths and the shops including the bakery whose oven and millstones were preserved, but above all the many Roman houses, some which still feature splendid decorations. Marble paving, mosaics and paintings bring the city back to life.</p>
<p>Day 5 - Wednesday NAPLES - PANORAMIC TOUR OF NAPLES (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>You'll begin the tour at Mergellina and Posillipo Hill, famous for their panoramic view over the Gulf of Naples. You'll then go on to Castel Nuovo, symbol of the city's architecture. The bus will take you to the Royal Palace, the outside façade of which is studded with statues of the King of Naples. You'll pass via the Teatro San Carlo, one of the oldest opera houses in Europe, and have free time in the Piazza Plebiscito before going back to the ship.</p>
<p>Day 5 - Wednesday NAPLES - POMPEI (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>The town was a flourishing community with over 25,000 inhabitants when it met with catastrophe on 24 August in the year 79 CE. Its inhabitants were killed by the eruption of Vesuvius as they went about their everyday lives, and a shroud of cinders kept the site almost intact. As well as the incredible collection of monuments, homes, works of art and furnishings that the excavations have uncovered, the site reveals daily life in ancient times in stunning detail. Guided walking tour of the site lasting 2 hours. Please note: uneven and potentially slippery surfaces in wet weather, including cobblestone paths.</p>
<p>Day 6 - Thursday CIVITAVECCHIA / ROME VATICAN (1 day - free lunch)*</p>	<p>Follow your guide through this labyrinth of chambers and galleries that make up the famous Vatican Museums, admire a selection of art treasures collected by the Popes over the centuries, and marvel at Michelangelo's impressive Last Judgment adorning the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel. Then discover the largest church in the world: Saint Peter's Basilica and its splendid square and surrounding columns. A free afternoon in the Vatican district allows for lunch and a stroll through the alleys, or to visit another site of your choice. PLACES LIMITED. (Entrances to the Vatican Museums subject to quota, subject to confirmation by the local authorities 60 days in advance). This excursion involves a 3-hour drive and the guided tour is entirely on foot with many stairs.</p>
<p>Day 6 - Thursday CIVITAVECCHIA - BAROQUE ROME (1 day - lunch not included)*</p>	<p>Accompanied by a guide, you'll admire the famous Fontana di Trevi and Piazza di Spagna, from which you have a wonderful view of the Chiesa della Trinita dei Monti. Piazza Navona is another must, which gets its unusual shape from its origin as the Domiziano stadium. Free time for lunch and a stroll through the city, or more sightseeing. This excursion includes 3 hours drive round trip and 3km of walking tour.</p>
<p>Day 6 - Thursday CIVITAVECCHIA / IMPERIAL ROME (1 day- free lunch)*</p>	<p>This guided tour offers you the unique opportunity to discover one of the oldest buildings in Rome, symbol of the Eternal City: the Colosseum! After a tour through the Roman remains of the capital, visiting the Arch of Titus and the Roman Forum, you will visit the interior of the Colosseum, heart of the Imperial City during the time of Augustus! Then you have a free afternoon to have lunch and stroll through the alleys or choose to visit somewhere else, perhaps Santa Maria Maggiore? One of the four patriarchal basilicas. PLACES LIMITED. (Entrances to the Colosseum subject to quota, subject to confirmation by the local authorities 90 days in advance). This excursion involves a 3-hour drive.</p>

Day 6 - Thursday
CIVITAVECCHIA / OSTIE*

Discover Ostia Antica, the ancient port of Rome, on an ideal shore excursion from the port of Civitavecchia. Surrounded by cypress trees and umbrella pines, this exceptionally well-preserved archaeological site offers a unique insight into everyday life in Ancient Rome. As you walk through the ruins — houses, baths, shops, and public spaces — your guide will bring to life the history of this once-thriving commercial city, which flourished for nearly eight centuries. A fascinating visit away from the crowds, perfectly suited to your cruise schedule, with guaranteed return to your ship.

Day 7 - Friday
ELBA / IN THE
FOOTSTEPS OF
NAPOLEON (1/2 day)*

Visit Villa San Martino or Dei Mulini, where Napoleon spent his ten months of exile on the island of Elba, before exploring the pretty fishing port and fort in the little village of Porto Azzuro. On the road towards Portoferraio, stop for a wine tasting at the La Chiusa wine estate. You'll find that wine tastes even better when you're standing amidst the vines with the sea in the distance.

Formalities

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
