





Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
Day 2 - Sunday ELBE	France and Italy vied for possession of this island, where Napoleon lived out his years of exile before it went back to Italy in 1860. Today it lives in peace, with national park status. Ship at anchor, water sports available, no direct access to a beach.
Day 3 - Monday PORTOVECCHIO	Set between the sea and mountains, Porto-Vecchio has fine sandy beaches, crystal-clear waters and preserved countryside. A stopover in the heart of authentic Corsica, combining Mediterranean charm and unspoiled nature. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
Day 4 - Tuesday AJACCIO	Hugging the crystal-clear waters of the gulf, this city remembers its most famous son, Napoleon. The best way to appreciate its multitude of brightly coloured buildings and winding alleyways is on foot. Ship at anchor, water sports available.
Day 5 - Wednesday CALVI	From its commanding position dominating the ocean, Calvi keeps a faithful watch over the wild coastline and mountain backdrop. A white sand beach and shady palm trees welcome visitors to the island. Ship at anchor. Water sports.
Day 6 - Thursday MARSEILLE	Founded in 600 BCE by Greek sailors from Phocaea, the Old Port and its historic neighbourhoods, the Byzantine-style Notre-Dame-de-la-Garde basilica, its sunny corniche facing the sea and its wild rocky inlets make it a city of great contrasts. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

Day 2 - Sunday
ELBA / IN THE
FOOTSTEPS OF
NAPOLEON (1/2 day)*

Visit Villa San Martino or Dei Mulini, where Napoleon spent his ten months of exile on the island of Elba, before exploring the pretty fishing port and fort in the little village of Porto Azzuro. On the road towards Portoferraio, stop for a wine tasting at the La Chiusa wine estate. You'll find that wine tastes even better when you're standing amidst the vines with the sea in the distance.

Day 2 - Sunday
ELBE / URBAN
TREKKING IN
PORTOFERRAIO
(1/2 day)*

Set off on a guided fitness walk and take on the inclines. You'll be rewarded with a splendid view of the town and the private beaches that can be seen only from the summit. This walk will take you to Fort Falcone, where refreshments will be provided.

Day 3 - Monday
PORTOVECCHIO /
BONIFACIO & CAVES
AND CLIFFS (1/2 day)*

Discover Bonifacio, the jewel of southern Corsica, on a memorable excursion combining a guided visit of the historic town with a one-hour boat cruise along its spectacular coastline.

After exploring the famous cliff-top citadel, enjoy a guided boat ride to admire the breathtaking limestone cliffs, officially declared French National Heritage in 1996. From the sea, you will discover sea caves, hidden coves, and dramatic rock formations, accessible only by boat. A perfect blend of culture and nature, this excursion offers unforgettable views and is ideally suited to your stop in Porto-Vecchio.

Day 4 - Tuesday
AJACCIO / THE ISLANDS
"ÎLES SANGUINAIRES"

Share an unforgettable moment aboard your hybrid ship and sail in the Gulf of Ajaccio to discover the imperial city and the archipelago of the Sanguinaires Islands. Enjoy a one-hour stopover on the MEZU MARE island to a swimming break or a walk to the Alphonse DAUDET lighthouse

Some of Corsica's most beautiful villages blend beautifully into the landscape of La Balagne. You'll take the scenic route, with superb views of the plain, the sea, the Bay of Calvi and the Ile Rousse. You'll discover the maquis, with its fabulous fragrance and vegetation, and the mediaeval village of Sant'Antonino, the island's most ancient village, perched up high on the rocks, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy a cool glass of Muscat.

Formalities

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
