





Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Thursday MARSEILLE	Founded in 600 BCE by Greek sailors from Phocaea, the Old Port and its historic neighbourhoods, the Byzantine-style Notre-Dame-de-la-Garde basilica, its sunny corniche facing the sea and its wild rocky inlets make it a city of great contrasts. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
Day 2 - Friday SÈTE	Located between the Mediterranean and the Étang de Thau, famous for its oysters, Sète is also known as the "Venice of the Languedoc" because of its network of canals. It has retained its old world charm thanks to the ports located in the heart of the city. Boat docked, dive locker closed, stopover without beach.
Day 3 - Saturday MAHÓN	Menorca's port invites you in to discover the unspoiled charms of the "blue and white island". Its cliffs and inlets hide reminders of megalithic times: navetes, taulas, and talaiots. Ship docked, no water sports and no direct access to a beach.
Day 4 - Sunday PALMA DE MALLORCA	Dominated by its imposing cathedral, considered to be one of the most beautiful Gothic structures in Spain, the capital of the Balearic Islands has a twin identity, combining modernism and traditions. Ship docked, no water sports.
Day 5 - Monday VALENCE	Covering 2,000 m ² , the gothic architecture of the Lonja de la Seda (Silk Exchange) has Unesco World Heritage status. It faces the Mercado Centrale, one of the most beautiful covered markets in Europe. Ship docked, no water sports and no direct access to a beach.
Day 6 - Tuesday ALICANTE	The Greeks called it the white citadel and the Romans the city of light. Closely linked, the old town, the port and the beach make this a city with its face turned resolutely towards the sea. Ship docked, no water sports, beach.
Day 7 - Wednesday ALMERIA	Built against the foothills of an arid deserted sierra, the city faces out onto an azure sea. Dominated by one of the most beautiful fortresses in Andalusia, it is also home to a stunning cathedral. Ship docked, no water sports.
Day 8 - Thursday MALAGA	Cosmopolitan Andalusia has 300 days of sunshine a year. It's also a major landmark in the history of Cubism - you can visit the house where Picasso was born and the museum with over 200 of his works. Ship docked in port. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

<p>Day 2 - Friday SETE / THAU CANALS AND POND (2 hours)*</p>	<p>Come and see the city of Sète from another angle! Navigate the calm waters of the canals to the characteristic district of Pointe Courte and admire the different styles of facades that give the city its charm. This crossing via the maritime canal and the fixed and swing bridges will take you to the lake of Thau, a real inland sea of over 20 kilometres, to learn about the breeding of oysters and mussels.</p>
<p>Day 3 - Saturday MAHON / MAHON AND THE MONTE TORO*</p>	<p>After a tour of the best views in the bustling centre of Mahon, the capital of Menorca since the 17th century, you'll travel to Monte Toro. As this is the highest peak, you can enjoy panoramic views of the entire island.</p>
<p>Day 4 - Sunday PALMA DE MALLORCA / VALDEMOSSA, SOLLER*</p>	<p>Made famous by the stay of George Sand and Frédéric Chopin during the winter of 1839, the charming village of Valldemossa will enchant you with its traditional Majorcan houses and picturesque pedestrian streets, beautifully decorated with colorful hanging flower pots that fill the village with fragrance and charm. The journey continues to the village of Sóller, nestled in the heart of a deep and fertile valley. Renowned for its citrus groves, Sóller owes its name to this rich agricultural heritage. You will have the opportunity to experience the historic tramway connecting Sóller to its port, enjoying the scenic ride through the lush landscape. Afterward, savor a delicious lunch at the restaurant Mar & Sol, offering exquisite local flavors and an inviting atmosphere by the sea. A perfect excursion combining history, culture, scenic landscapes, and authentic Majorcan cuisine.</p>
<p>Day 4 - Sunday PALMA DE MALLORCA / PALMA HISTORIQUE & BELLVER CASTLE*</p>	<p>Stroll through its historic center and let yourself be charmed by its sunlit streets, elegant facades, and authentic atmosphere. Continue your exploration with a visit to Bellver Castle, a Gothic masterpiece offering an exceptional panoramic view of the bay. An unforgettable experience that combines culture, history, and Mediterranean beauty.</p>
<p>Day 5 - Monday VALENCE - HISTORICAL VALENCE (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Come and discover the heart and soul of Valencia, one of Spain's most vibrant and dynamic cities. Accompanied by your guide, explore the city's most emblematic neighborhoods and immerse yourself in its rich history and lively atmosphere. Your visit includes Valencia's iconic landmarks: the impressive Serrano Towers, the bustling Central Market (closed on Sundays) and the magnificent Gothic Cathedral, a powerful symbol of the city's Moorish and Christian heritage. (Please note: Sundays & on November 2nd, 2026, when the Cathedral is closed, the visit will be replaced by La Lonja de la Seda, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.) This excursion offers the perfect introduction to Valencia, blending history, architecture, and local life for an unforgettable cultural experience.</p>
<p>Day 5 - Monday VALENCE - VALENCE TAPAS TOUR*</p>	<p>Come and discover the heart and soul of Valencia, one of the most dynamic and vibrant cities in Spain. We will guide you through its iconic neighborhoods as you explore must-see landmarks: the Serrano Towers, La Lonja, and the magnificent Gothic Cathedral, a symbol of the city's rich Moorish past (Please note: Sundays & on November 2nd, 2026, when the Cathedral is closed, the visit will be replaced by La Lonja de la Seda, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.). To complete this authentic experience, you will enjoy 4 carefully selected tapas, accompanied by 2 drinks and a traditional horchata, a true local delight. An excursion that combines culture, history, and gastronomy to let you experience Valencia fully and vividly.</p>
<p>Day 6 - Tuesday ALICANTE / ALICANTE PANORAMIC AND GASTRONOMIC*</p>	<p>Discover the enchanting hinterland with a guided vineyard tour, where you'll taste some of the region's most renowned wines. You will enjoy, also, a scenic tour of Alicante. 1h by bus until the vineyard.</p>
<p>Day 8 - Thursday MALAGA / MALAGA AND PICASSO (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>You will take a trip around the historic and modern center of Malaga. You will pass by the Cathedral, a very beautiful example of Spanish Renaissance architecture, before going to the Picasso museum which tells the story of 80 years the artist's work, who was a native of Malaga. Your guide will teach you how to understand his works, from the most famous to the most obscure.</p>
<p>Day 8 - Thursday MALAGA / MALAGA AND CATHEDRAL*</p>	<p>Discover the charm of Malaga on a journey through both its historic heart and modern districts. Guided through the city's lively streets, you will experience the unique blend of tradition, culture, and contemporary life that defines this Andalusian city. The highlight of the visit is the Cathedral of Malaga, a magnificent example of Spanish Renaissance architecture. Known as La Manquita, the cathedral impresses with its elegant proportions, rich artistic heritage, and fascinating history. An ideal excursion to experience the essential sights of Malaga, combining history, architecture, and Andalusian charm.</p>

Formalities

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
