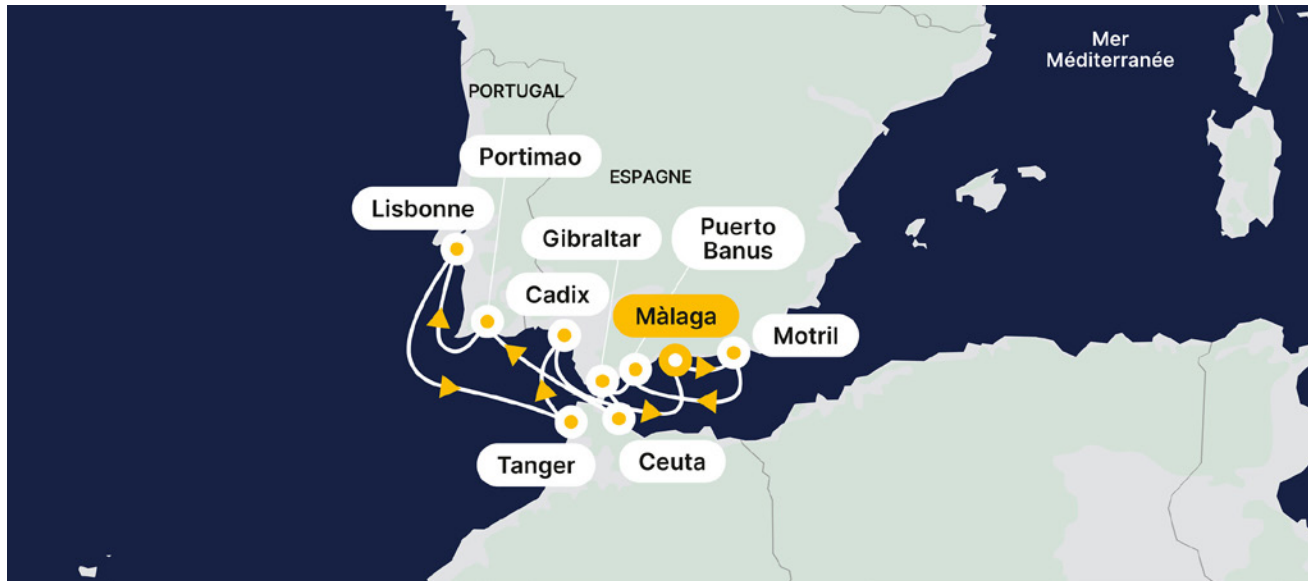

DAY 1 - THURSDAY 5 NOVEMBER

MÁLAGA

Nestled on the Costa del Sol, Málaga beautifully combines a Mediterranean climate and a rich cultural heritage. As the birthplace of Pablo Picasso, visitors interested in Cubism can tour the artist's childhood home and a museum that houses over 200 of his works. Its historic centre, buzzing alleyways and urban beaches ensure the perfect balance between art, relaxation and an easy-going lifestyle. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. DAY 2 - FRIDAY 6 NOVEMBER

MOTRIL

The Encarnación Church, built on the foundations of an ancient mosque, rubs shoulders with the elegant Baroque town hall. The Virgen de la Cabeza Sanctuary is on the site where King Boabdil's mother once lived, completing this discovery-packed cultural journey. Motril is the capital of the Tropical Coast, blending fascinating heritage, spirituality, and architecture. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

DAY 3 - SATURDAY 7 NOVEMBER

PUERTO BANUS/ MARBELLA

Located in Marbella, Puerto Banús is an iconic Andalusian marina. Famous for its glam vibe, it combines the charm of an old flower-lined town with the buzz of a modern destination. Bordered by chic beaches, the town has managed to preserve its authentic charm despite the development of hotels and modern residences. CEUTA

Wandering through the village is like walking in a living postcard, where every corner offers a perfect photo opportunity.

A stroll through the historic center reveals artisan shops, picturesque squares, and stunning views over the Mediterranean. Highlights include the unique Mijas Bullring, one of the smallest in Spain, and the Chapel of the Virgin of the Rock.

A must-stop is Taberna del Pintor, a cozy tavern known for its warm atmosphere and traditional Andalusian flavors.

Here, you can enjoy a drink with local specialties such as lomo de orza, a true taste of the region.

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and

may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return. We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence. Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
