<p>Day 2 - Monday TANGIER / WHITE TANGIER*</p>	<p>Discover Tangier and its most iconic sights. The excursion begins with a scenic drive to Cap Spartel, located at the northwestern tip of Africa, offering breathtaking views over the Strait of Gibraltar where the Atlantic Ocean meets the Mediterranean Sea. You will then explore Tangier the White, a legendary city that inspired many artists and writers. The tour continues through the Kasbah and the old Medina, with their lively and picturesque streets. Enjoy some free time to stroll, shop for souvenirs, or relax with a traditional mint tea. The excursion also includes a visit to the Kasbah Museum, housed in the former Sultan's palace, featuring fascinating collections and stunning views over Tangier Bay.</p>
<p>Day 3 - Tuesday CASABLANCA*</p>	<p>The biggest city in North Africa is famous for its stunning architectural beauty. Spacious avenues edged with elegant buildings, joyfully combining art deco and Moorish architecture, spread out from the centre, jostling with cupolas, lookout towers, colonnades, cedarwood balconies... Not far from the port, the Hassan II Mosque and its dizzying 200-metre high minaret dominates the city. Plasterers, wood-carvers, Zellige tile artisans, metal-workers and craftsmen of every sort have made this building a monument for all eternity. You will enjoy a sight-seeing tour of the city, stopping off to visit Notre Dame de Casablanca cathedral, the Royal Palace area and the Central Market.</p>
<p>Day 5 - Thursday ARRECFE / THE FIRE MOUNTAIN (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Set off to discover the Fire Mountains in the breathtaking Timanfaya National Park. Accompanied by your French-speaking guide, explore the striking volcanic landscapes of Lanzarote, shaped by centuries of eruptions. At the end of your journey, enjoy a typical local aperitif in the authentic setting of the Monumento al Campesino. An unforgettable experience blending natural wonders and local traditions.</p>
<p>Day 5 - Thursday ARRECFE / CESAR MANRIQUE : HÉRITAGE ARCHITECTURAL DE LANZAROTE*</p>	<p>Come and discover the architectural heritage of César Manrique, the brilliant architect who decided to turn his native island into one of the most beautiful places in the world. His different architectural projects all have the main characteristic of the inclusion of rocks, stones and lava flows, resulting in living spaces in harmony with the island's mineral environment. You will also be able to explore the amazing "jameos del Agua" with its tunnels and panoramic terraces, as well as his foundation constructed on a lava flow where the architect's house was built.</p>
<p>Day 15 - Sunday BARBADOS / REMOTE BARBADOS IN A 4X4 (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>From sugar cane fields to tropical forest via the village of Bathsheba, you'll drive over dirt tracks through the most inaccessible parts of the island and see the finest views of the Atlantic coast. (bumpy road)</p>
<p>Day 15 - Sunday BARBADOS / SUBMARINE (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>A unique opportunity to admire the splendour of the tropical sea. Venture into this realm of silence, 50 metres down, on a high-tech submarine. Discover the coral reefs (sea fans, sponges) and fish (angel, butterfly, surgeon and boxfish, to name but a few). Visibility depending on weather.</p>
<p>Day 15 - Sunday BARBADOS / LITTLE ENGLAND (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Don't miss this opportunity to discover the treasures of what we call "Little England" in the West Indies. First Farley Hill, a popular meeting place for Barbadians, then Bathsheba, a small fishing village beaten by the waves of the Atlantic and known to surfers from all over the world. Treat yourself to a refreshing drink at the new Hillcrest Community Center and finish with Codrington College. Long way by bus.</p>
<p>Day 15 - Sunday BARBADOS / HISTORIC PLANTATION & TRAIN (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Embark on a magical train ride through the rolling hills of St. Nicholas Abbey. Discover the historic Jacobean mansion, its steam mill, and rum distillery. Enjoy breathtaking views after a scenic journey along Cherry Tree Avenue. On your way back, admire the wild beauty of the stunning East Coast.</p>

Formalities

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
