



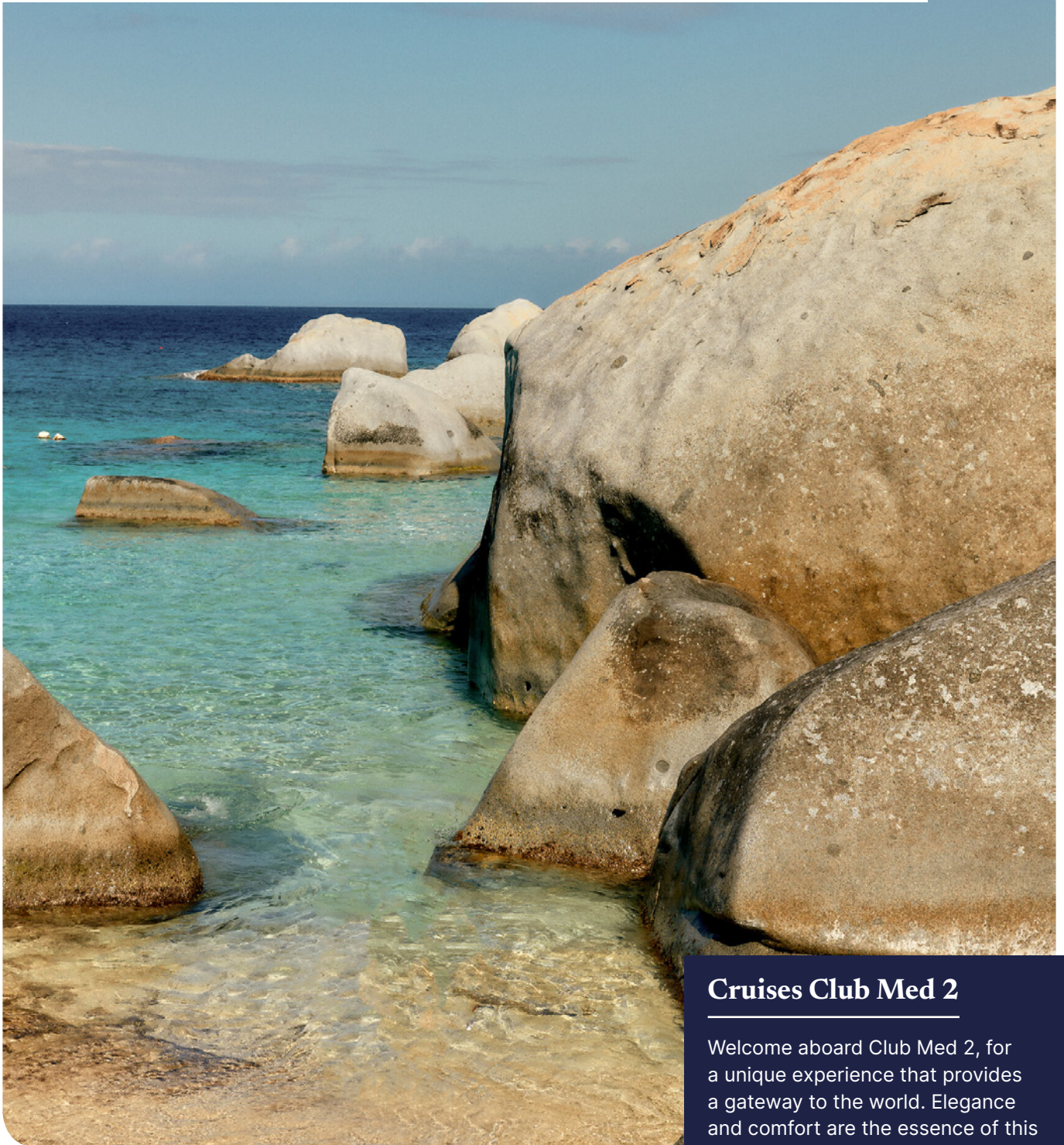

Day 1 - Friday FORT-DE-FRANCE	Fort-de-France is the largest town in the French West Indies, famous for its cosmopolitan vibe and tropical lifestyle. With its colourful markets, quaint houses and metallic architecture, the town showcases a buzzing Creole lifestyle that is both urban and welcoming. A colourful stopover that blends tradition with the contemporary. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
Day 2 - Saturday THE SAINTS	Small huts and doll's houses gracefully line a bay considered to be one of the most beautiful in the world. This tiny archipelago has an astonishingly varied natural heritage — an enchanting, rare and precious place. Anchored boat, water sports available (excluding water skiing).
Day 3 - Sunday SAINT-BARTHLEMY	This steep island is all about luxury. It beautifully showcases the serenity of an unspoiled environment and discreet tourism, loved by a discerning clientele. Its 17 private, varied beaches only add to the charming setting. Boat at anchor, access to the beach, and water sports available.

Its picturesque harbour, bustling with old inns and traditional pubs, gives it an undeniable historic charm. Boat at anchor, access to the beach, dive locker closed.
Day 9 - Saturday POINTE-À-PITRE	Pointe-à-Pitre is Guadeloupe's main town and showcases all the sensory pleasures of Caribbean island life. The market stalls are laden with spices, flowers, fish, and fruits for an authentic flavour and music-filled Creole vibe. A buzzing stopover, combining local traditions with a tropical atmosphere. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

Formalities

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
