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

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## Itinerary of your cruise

<b>Day 1 - Saturday</b> FORT-DE-FRANCE	Fort-de-France is the largest town in the French West Indies, famous for its cosmopolitan vibe and tropical lifestyle. With its colourful markets, quaint houses and metallic architecture, the town showcases a buzzing Creole lifestyle that is both urban and welcoming. A colourful stopover that blends tradition with the contemporary. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
<b>Day 2 - Sunday</b> DOMINICA	Nature reigns supreme on this lush island. A destination criss-crossed by rivers that irrigate a territory formed by volcanic eruptions, where every valley and tropical forest seems to buzz with a unique energy. Home to the last of the Caribbean indigenous people, Dominica offers a rare opportunity to immerse yourself in an unspoiled biodiversity of rugged mountains, hot springs, and crystal-clear waterfalls. Boat at anchor, water sports available.
<b>Day 3 - Monday</b> SAINT-BARTHELEMY	This steep island is all about luxury. It beautifully showcases the serenity of an unspoiled environment and discreet tourism, loved by a discerning clientele. Its 17 private, varied beaches only add to the charming setting. Boat at anchor, access to the beach, and water sports available.
<b>Day 4 - Tuesday</b> ANGUILLA	A long ribbon of stunning white sand lines the turquoise waters. A tiny, discreet island that attracts a VIP clientele in search of beauty and privacy makes this the perfect hideaway. Boat at anchor, access to the beach, and water sports available.
<b>Day 5 - Wednesday</b> PRICKLY PEAR / VIRGIN GORDA	The 'Caribbean Beach Club' day on a privatised beach, perfect for a luxurious, relaxing break in a superb natural setting. Guests who book the "Virgin Gorda Panoramas" excursion will discover a spectacular geological treat. Gigantic granite boulders, sculpted by erosion, form natural emerald pools bordered by white sand. A unique landscape, between sea and rock, perfect for a refreshing dip and or to relax while admiring the scenery. Anchored boat, water sports at the beach (excluding water-skiing).
<b>Day 6 - Thursday</b> NEVIS	This tiny island is a fascinating destination situated next to Saint Kitts and home to a magnificent volcano. Hot springs, archaeological sites, a rainforest populated by green monkeys, and a passion for cricket - a living painting that blends a lush landscape with deep-rooted traditions. Boat at anchor, access to the beach, and water sports available.
<b>Day 7 - Friday</b> ANTIGUA	The indented coastline of this former British colony has created incredible beaches, lined with secret coves and stretches of golden sand. Its picturesque harbour, bustling with old inns and traditional pubs, gives it an undeniable historic charm. Boat at anchor, access to the beach, dive locker closed.

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## Excursions of your cruise

<b>Day 2 - Sunday</b> <b>ROSEAU/ UNUSUAL SWIMS IN DOMINICA</b> (1/2 day)*	Travel to the untamed summits of the island, and after a short walk you will come to a natural rock pool and narrow canyon fed by a waterfall where you can swim surrounded by nature. (Undeveloped natural site). Continue to the village of Wotten Waven, also known as the Wellness Village for its therapeutic pools fed by hot sulphur water. Be sure to take a soothing bath in the midst of fumaroles and porous volcanic rocks.
<b>Day 2 - Sunday</b> <b>ROSEAU/ NATURAL WONDERS OF DOMINICA</b> (1/2 day)*	Come and enjoy the most popular natural attractions that Dominica has to offer! Spanny Falls are still a bit of a secret, even though they are the height of a 7-story building. Continue on to the Trois Pitons National Park, and cross the forest to the Emerald Pool and its 12-metre waterfall where you can cool off (undeveloped area). You will finally make your way to the village of Trafalgar to the viewing platform to see the majestic waterfalls that the village is famous for before returning to the boat.
<b>Day 4 - Tuesday</b> <b>ANGUILLA/ DÉJEUNER LANGOUSTE À SANDY ISLAND*</b>	Take a short 10-minute boat ride to the stunning Sandy Island, a true tropical paradise. Swim in crystal-clear turquoise waters, explore vibrant reefs, or relax on soft white sand. Enjoy premium food and drinks with effortless luxury. After a blissful day, ferry back to the mainland and rejoin your ship.
<b>Day 5 - Wednesday</b> <b>VIRGIN GORDA/ PANORAMA</b> (1/2 day)*	Board an open-top local bus and follow the scenic ridge road, offering breathtaking panoramic views of the Virgin Islands. At the end of the route, a geological wonder awaits — the famous Baths, with their stunning granite boulders forming natural pools, perfect for relaxation and exploration. Please note: only guests who have booked this excursion will have the opportunity to visit Virgin Gorda and The Baths. The tour includes a panoramic drive in an open bus, a accompanied walk through The Baths, and a complimentary local drink at Top of the Baths restaurant. <b>▲ Swimming is not permitted in case of a red flag.</b>
<b>Day 6 - Thursday</b> <b>NEVIS/ ISLAND HIGHLIGHTS AND BOTANICAL GARDEN*</b>	Enjoy a scenic drive through Charlestown, Nevis, and glimpse the island's charming Caribbean lifestyle and architecture. Visit the birthplace of Alexander Hamilton, the first U.S. Treasurer, and explore the island's oldest Anglican church, built in 1643 with stunning views of St. Kitts. Journey through quaint villages to the lush Botanical Gardens, featuring tropical plants from around the world, including orchids, cacti, bamboo, and water lily pools. Step into the spectacular glass conservatory, home to a rainforest, Mayan temple, waterfalls, and streams. Browse the unique gift shop for botanical-themed treasures and enjoy a complimentary tropical fruit punch. Discover the beauty, history, and serenity that make Nevis truly unforgettable.
<b>Day 6 - Thursday</b> <b>NEVIS/ HIKING*</b>	Embark on a moderate hike along the slopes of Nevis's dormant volcano, rising 3,232 feet above sea level. Wander through lush tropical rainforest surrounding the historic Mountravers Estate, a former 18th-century sugar plantation turned boutique hotel. Learn about the estate's fascinating history while spotting wild green monkeys, listening to tree frogs, and feeling the bamboo palms sway in the breeze. Enjoy breathtaking views of Nevis's west coast and neighboring islands, perfect for stunning photos. Your journey ends at picturesque Pinneys Beach, where you can relax on a sun-lounger under an umbrella. Refresh with two complimentary drinks and soak up the gentle Caribbean breeze or take a dip in the crystal-clear sea.
<b>Day 7 - Friday</b> <b>ANTIGUA - EMERALD CRUISE*</b>	Set sail on a stylish catamaran and cruise along the island's picturesque coastline to discover one of its stunning beaches. Enjoy some free time to swim in the crystal-clear waters or unwind on the soft white sand. Then, hop back on board for a scenic ride to another idyllic beach on the island's western shore, where you'll anchor for more swimming and sunbathing. A delicious lobster lunch will be served, perfectly paired with a glass of sparkling wine. To top it all off, an open bar awaits on the return journey—everything you need for a perfect, carefree day at sea.
<b>Day 8 - Saturday</b> <b>FORT DE FRANCE/ HABITATION CLÉMENT</b> (1/2 journée)*	Discover Habitation Clément, an exceptional rum distillery in many ways. It includes a colonial mansion that welcomed presidents Mitterrand and Bush after the Gulf War, botanical gardens, as well as a distillery that produces the most famous rums in the French Antilles. Your tour will end with a tasting of old rum. For reasons of airport security, all purchases of bottles of rum made at the plantation must be packed in a suitcase destined for the baggage hold before checking in for your flight.
<b>Day 8 - Saturday</b> <b>MARTINIQUE - DÉCOUVERTE EN 4X4</b> (1/2 day)*	Explore the most beautiful scenery in the whole of "Flower Island". Your driver will take you on a stunning route, featuring rainforest, rivers and plantations. Your trip will end with a visit to a distillery.

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## Formalities

### HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
