





Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday FORT-DE-FRANCE	Fort-de-France is the largest town in the French West Indies, famous for its cosmopolitan vibe and tropical lifestyle. With its colourful markets, quaint houses and metallic architecture, the town showcases a buzzing Creole lifestyle that is both urban and welcoming. A colourful stopover that blends tradition with the contemporary. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
Day 2 - Sunday ST LUCIA	Saint Lucia is an unspoiled volcanic island that combines incredible nature and ecological commitment. Its two majestic, deep green peaks soar above carefully protected landscapes. Anchored boat, with access to the beach and water sports (excluding water-skiing). No free diving activities planned.
Day 3 - Monday TOBAGO CAYS	At the heart of the Grenadines archipelago, Tobago Cays reveals a spectacular mosaic of blues, sculpted by the region's most beautiful coral reef. Shoals of colourful fish glide through its crystal-clear waters, offering a fascinating natural spectacle. Ship at anchor. Beach access, water sports available (except water skiing).
Day 4 - Tuesday GRENADE	The island of spices: an evocative name for a destination imbued with the bewitching scents of nutmeg, cinnamon, and vanilla. A fascinating place to explore as you follow in the historic footprints of various colonial powers that once inhabited this land. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
Day 5 - Wednesday MAYREAU	The smallest island in the Grenadines has maintained its charming sense of privacy and is home to a single village. It defines idyllic beaches: fine sand, crystal-clear waters, and reefs swarming with multicoloured fish. A real natural treasure, that is discreet and beautifully preserved. The beach will be privatised for an exclusive 'Caribbean Beach Club' day, perfect for a luxurious, relaxing break in a superb natural setting. Anchored boat, water sports at the beach (excluding water-skiing).
Day 6 - Thursday SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA	Let yourself be lulled by the soothing rhythm of the waves and savour every moment aboard our exceptional sailboat. Relax on the decks' sun loungers, enjoy a refreshing dip in one of our two pools, work up a sweat in the Fitness Centre or treat yourself to wellness break at the spa... Live life at your own pace. Our friendly and attentive GO team and crew will be on hand to make your day as fun as it is unforgettable.
Day 7 - Friday BONAIRE	A Dutch island in the Leeward Antilles, Bonaire is known for its environmental commitment and incredible marine life. Its coral belt makes it a popular diving destination while elegant pink flamingoes flock to its lagoons. A stopover where unspoiled nature meets tropical beauty. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
Day 8 - Saturday CURAÇAO	The largest of the ABC islands, Curaçao is home to striking colonial architecture and a mixed-race culture. The colourful facades that line the harbour in Willemstad, the capital, recall Amsterdam's canals, livened up with a Caribbean twist. Dutch and Spanish influences blend in a buzzing ambiance that combines historical heritage with tropical charm. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
Day 9 - Sunday SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA	Live the dream thanks to a wealth of onboard experiences on our incredible sailboat. Whether you choose some relaxing downtime or a buzzing activity, every moment is about pleasure and freedom.
Day 10 - Monday LA ROMANA	Officially founded in 1897, this southern Dominican Republic port town owes its development to the installation of a large sugar cane mill built by Italian immigrants some twenty years later. It was first established in 1851 to facilitate maritime traffic, meaning the port has played a key role in the region's economic development. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

Excursions of your cruise

<p>Day 2 - Sunday ST LUCIA / ISLAND TOUR (1/2 day - afternoon)*</p>	<p>You'll discover the island's colonial past when we stop at St Mark's House in Castries. You'll have some amazing views of the island's lush vegetation as we drive along the Caribbean coast. We'll visit a former plantation, Morne Coubaril Estate, a gift from Louis XIV to the Deveaux family. To the present day the family's descendants produce sugar cane, copra, coconuts and manioc. And you'll discover La Soufrière with its fascinating geological activity, before getting back onto the boat in Soufrière Bay. Hilly road and long bus ride.</p>
<p>Day 3 - Monday TOBAGO CAYS / CATAMARAN MORPION ISLAND (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Morpion - also known as Mopio - will make your paradise island dream come true! A tiny white sand island with a straw hut and palm tree leaf roof, the main function of this speck of paradise is to indicate the way to sailors. This highly photogenic spot has featured in magazines worldwide: today, it's all yours!</p>
<p>Day 4 - Tuesday GRENADA / ISLAND TOUR (day)*</p>	<p>The Spice Isle will captivate you with its lush landscapes and enchanting aromas. Discover the famous Diamond Chocolate Factory in Victoria, where Jouvay chocolate—ranked among the best in the world—is produced. Several stops along the way allow you to explore the island's authentic and thriving nature. The experience concludes with a delicious local lunch at Belmont Estate, an 18th-century cocoa plantation.</p>
<p>Day 4 - Tuesday GRENADA / FORT AND BEACHE BY LOCAL BUS (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>You'll discover St Georges - the charming capital, known as the Little San Francisco of the West Indies - in a vintage truck. You'll stop at the Frederick Fort that look out over the town, and after a detour in the nearby hills, where you'll have a great view of the interior of the island, you'll have the chance to swim from one of Grenada's most beautiful beaches. Scenic island tour by open-roof, non-air-conditioned Creole bus with a local French-speaking guide, including a visit to Fort Frederick located on a hillside, followed by 1 hour of swimming with sunbed and drinks included: mineral water, juices, sodas, rum punch, and beer.</p>
<p>Day 4 - Tuesday GRENADA / LA CAPIJE (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>You will begin this beautiful forest hike from Grand Étang, crossing a plantation where you can observe cocoa, nutmeg, and banana trees. You will then continue to the Bamboo Waterfall, perfect for a refreshing swim. Please note: the hike includes a river crossing, so be sure to wear appropriate footwear.</p>
<p>Day 4 - Tuesday GRENADA / WATERFALLS AND CHOCOLATE (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>This aromatic island tour will allow you to get to know everything about the "Jouvay" organic chocolate production at the Diamond Chocolate Factory nestled in the village of Victoria on the west coast of Grenada. You'll find it in an 18th-century converted rum distillery, which was built by French monks. Nowadays, the factory's responsible for making 'Jouvay' - one of the world's top 10 chocolates, according to National Geographic. This chocolate's completely organic and you'll learn how it's made - from the harvest of the cocoa beans, to watching them dry on trays under the Caribbean sun. A visit to the garden of cocoa trees to see, cocoa, cloves, chili, nutmeg, flowers, fruits, followed by a delicious chocolate tasting, will conclude this pleasant visit to one of the most amazing sites in the Caribbean. On your way back, you make a detour to enjoy a swim (conditions permitting) in the natural lovely pool at the Concord Falls. Here the nutmeg and cocoa trees grow along the flanks of the hills in the tropical forest that is forever near. Please note: guests are advised to wear a swimsuit under a cover-up, bring sunscreen, a hat, sunglasses, and a towel. The order of the stops may vary. Long way by bus to discover the magnificence of the island.</p>
<p>Day 7 - Friday BONAIRE / ISLAND TOUR*</p>	<p>The island of Bonaire is one of the most charming of the former Dutch Antilles! After travelling through the capital Kralendijk, a pretty little pastel-coloured town, you'll take the coast road north. You'll see Lake Goto, a natural saltwater lake that's popular with flamingos. Then you'll continue on to Rincon village, founded by the Spanish in the 14th century, and then head South to see the saltpans and former slave houses.</p>
<p>Day 7 - Friday BONAIRE / SAIL AND SNORKEL (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>A unique opportunity to experience the joys of sailing as a small group. Take to the waves on a 13 metre single-hull boat, and see the underwater wonders of Bonaire's sparkling clear waters. After your swim, a refreshing aperitif rounds off the boat trip wonderfully.</p>
<p>Day 8 - Saturday CURACAO / THE COLORS OF CURACAO*</p>	<p>Discover Willemstad, the capital of Curacao by trolley train. Feast your eyes on the brightly coloured architecture of the UNESCO World Heritage Site city centre. Return to the ship at your own pace.</p>
<p>Day 8 - Saturday CURAÇAO / JEWISH HERITAGE TOUR*</p>	<p>Curacao has a fascinating Jewish history and boasts the oldest synagogue in the Americas. Also see the oldest cemetery in the Western Hemisphere, visit the Rooi Catoot Plantation House, and walk through the Old Jewish Quarter. the guided tour will be done in english.</p>
<p>Day 10 - Monday LA ROMANA / ONE DAY TO PUNTA CANA RESORT (1day)*</p>	<p>Before your flight, enjoy a wonderful day at the Punta Cana Resort, relax on its magnificent coconut palm beach and enjoy the Dominican atmosphere. Day pass from 10.30am to 4pm. Return directly to the airport of Punta Cana.</p>
<p>Day 10 - Monday LA ROMANA / CAVE OF WONDERS (1/2 day, morning)*</p>	<p>Explore the amazing 240 square metres of the Cave of Wonders. In the midst of stalactites, columns and other rock formations, you will discover ancient drawings left behind by the first indigenous people of the Caribbean. On your way back, you will stop off at La Romana where you can do a spot of shopping at the village market.</p>

Formalities

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
