DAY 1 - FRIDAY 22 JANUARY LA ROMANA

Officially founded in 1897, this southern Dominican Republic port town owes its development to the installation of a large sugar cane mill built by Italian immigrants some twenty years later. It was first established in 1851 to facilitate maritime traffic, meaning the port has played a key role in the region's economic development. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

DAY 3 - SUNDAY 24 JANUARY

PRICKLY PEAR / VIRGIN GORDA

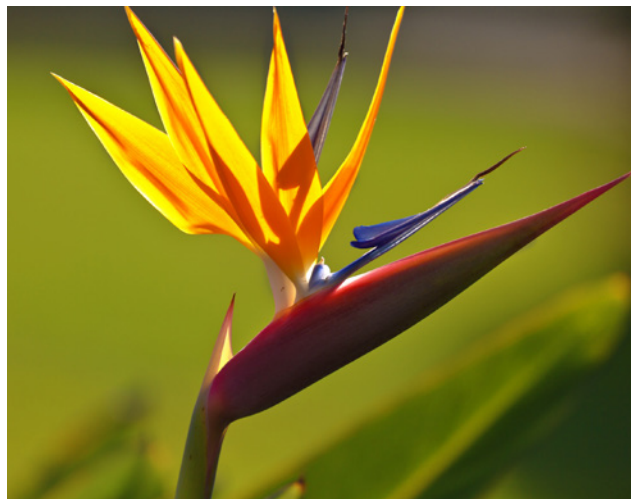
DAY 7 - THURSDAY 28 JANUARY

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

To make the most of your cruise with complete peace of mind, here is some information to keep in mind.



HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before

the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
