







Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday POINTE-À-PITRE	Pointe-à-Pitre is Guadeloupe's main town and showcases all the sensory pleasures of Caribbean island life. The market stalls are laden with spices, flowers, fish, and fruits for an authentic flavour and music-filled Creole vibe. A buzzing stopover, combining local traditions with a tropical atmosphere. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
Day 2 - Sunday DESHAIES	The village of Deshaies is in the lushest part of Papillon Island, and reveals the authentic charm of the easy-going Creole lifestyle. Time seems to stand still here, as you peacefully glide past this fishing village nestled between the green hills and peaceful shores, where nature reigns supreme. Anchored boat, water sports available (excluding water skiing).
Day 3 - Monday SAINT MARTIN	This island is famous for its diverse landscapes, with a succession of magnificent coves, rolling hills, and long stretches of sand dotted with marine-blue lagoons. It is also home to an astonishing mix of cultures with no fewer than 74 nationalities. A simple welcome sign marks the border between the French and Dutch territories, underlining the geopolitical singularity of this extraordinary destination. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
Day 4 - Tuesday SAINT-BARTHÉLEMY	This steep island is all about luxury. It beautifully showcases the serenity of an unspoiled environment and discreet tourism, loved by a discerning clientele. Its 17 private, varied beaches only add to the charming setting. Boat at anchor, access to the beach, and water sports available.
Day 5 - Wednesday ANGUILLA	A long ribbon of stunning white sand lines the turquoise waters. A tiny, discreet island that attracts a VIP clientele in search of beauty and privacy makes this the perfect hideaway. Boat at anchor, access to the beach, and water sports available.
Day 6 - Thursday PRICKLY PEAR / VIRGIN GORDA	The 'Caribbean Beach Club' day on a privatised beach, perfect for a luxurious, relaxing break in a superb natural setting. Guests who book the "Virgin Gorda Panoramas" excursion will discover a spectacular geological treat. Gigantic granite boulders, sculpted by erosion, form natural emerald pools bordered by white sand. A unique landscape, between sea and rock, perfect for a refreshing dip and or to relax while admiring the scenery. Anchored boat, water sports at the beach (excluding water-skiing).
Day 7 - Friday SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA	Live the dream thanks to a wealth of onboard experiences on our incredible sailboat. Whether you choose some relaxing downtime or a buzzing activity, every moment is about pleasure and freedom.
Day 8 - Saturday SAMANA BAY	Set in the heart of the Dominican Republic, the Samaná peninsula reveals a more secret and unspoiled side to the country. Far removed from the traditional tourist trail, this stretch of land bordered by the Caribbean Sea has an authentic charm. Deserted beaches with fine sand, lush vegetation and a vibrant local culture provide an exceptional natural setting. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
Day 9 - Sunday LA ROMANA	Officially founded in 1897, this southern Dominican Republic port town owes its development to the installation of a large sugar cane mill built by Italian immigrants some twenty years later. It was first established in 1851 to facilitate maritime traffic, meaning the port has played a key role in the region's economic development. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

Day 2 - Sunday DESHAIES - BOTANIC GARDEN*	Don't miss the incredible Botanic Garden, based at the former home of the comedian Coluche. You can see a dazzling array of tropical flowers and plants, a breathtaking waterfall and cute little birds from the parrot family. Then we'll round off the trip with an aperitif.
Day 2 - Sunday DESHAIES - SNORKELING ADVENTURE IN THE COUSTEAU RESERVE*	Embark on an unforgettable journey through the legendary Cousteau Reserve, guided by a certified instructor. Step aboard a friendly, small-group boat and explore three breathtaking sites: the Japanese Garden, the Coral Garden, and the Turtle Garden. Encounter colorful tropical fish, vibrant coral reefs, and graceful sea turtles in their natural habitat. All equipment is provided, and the tour is suitable for all levels, including beginners. End your adventure with a refreshing local juice or a traditional planteur punch — the perfect tropical touch to your Guadeloupe experience. Participants must feel comfortable in the water and be able to swim short distances if they choose to enter it.
Day 4 - Tuesday SAINT BARTH / CATAMARAN (1/2 day)*	Sail north along the stunning coast of St. Barths aboard a luxurious catamaran. Upon reaching the pristine Colombier Bay Nature Reserve, take the opportunity to swim in its crystal-clear waters for an unforgettable experience.
Day 5 - Wednesday ANGUILLA / DÉJEUNER LANGOUSTE À SANDY ISLAND*	Take a short 10-minute boat ride to the stunning Sandy Island, a true tropical paradise. Swim in crystal-clear turquoise waters, explore vibrant reefs, or relax on soft white sand. Enjoy premium food and drinks with effortless luxury. After a blissful day, ferry back to the mainland and rejoin your ship.
Day 6 - Thursday VIRGIN GORDA / PANORAMA (1/2 day)*	Board an open-top local bus and follow the scenic ridge road, offering breathtaking panoramic views of the Virgin Islands. At the end of the route, a geological wonder awaits — the famous Baths, with their stunning granite boulders forming natural pools, perfect for relaxation and exploration. Please note: only guests who have booked this excursion will have the opportunity to visit Virgin Gorda and The Baths. The tour includes a panoramic drive in an open bus, a accompanied walk through The Baths, and a complimentary local drink at Top of the Baths restaurant. ▲ Swimming is not permitted in case of a red flag.
Day 8 - Saturday SAMANA BAY / WHALES OBSERVATION SEAFARI*	Head off in a boat exclusively chartered for Club Med to meet humpback whales. During the mating season, hundreds of humpback whales come to the warm waters of the bay to breed. You will witness the amazing spectacle of the males leaping out of the water and the young whale calves swimming beside their mothers. On the way back, you'll have time to swim and enjoy the fine sandy beach at Cavo Levantado if wanted.
Day 9 - Sunday LA ROMANA / ONE DAY TO PUNTA CANA RESORT (1day)*	Before your flight, enjoy a wonderful day at the Punta Cana Resort, relax on its magnificent coconut palm beach and enjoy the Dominican atmosphere. Day pass from 10.30am to 4pm. Return directly to the airport of Punta Cana.
Day 9 - Sunday LA ROMANA / CAVE OF WONDERS (1/2 day, morning)*	Explore the amazing 240 square metres of the Cave of Wonders. In the midst of stalactites, columns and other rock formations, you will discover ancient drawings left behind by the first indigenous people of the Caribbean. On your way back, you will stop off at La Romana where you can do a spot of shopping at the village market.

Formalities

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
