


## Itinerary of your cruise

<b>Day 1 - Sunday</b> COLÓN	75 km from Panama City, Colón is the Atlantic entrance to the Panama Canal. Founded in the 19th century around the Transisthmian railway, the city quickly established itself as a strategic maritime trade hub. Today, it is home to the world's second largest free trade zone. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
<b>Day 2 - Monday</b> BOCAS DEL TORO	Nature rules at Bocas del Toro, a destination with white sandy beaches, coral reefs, and an exceptional marine life. A unique stopover with meditative views where time seems to stand still. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
<b>Day 3 - Tuesday</b> LIMÓN	Limón is Costa Rica's main port, nestled in a region blanketed with lush vegetation. Observe native species in unspoiled settings at national parks with unique views of the tropical rainforest and Caribbean coastline. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
<b>Day 4 - Wednesday</b> SAN ANDRÉS	San Andrés is an iconic seaside destination with white sandy beaches and crystal-clear waters in numerous shades of blue. A real Colombian Caribbean gem, the island boasts a unique cultural wealth, inherited from a past shaped by encounters and multiple influences. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
<b>Day 5 - Thursday</b> SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA	Live the dream thanks to a wealth of onboard experiences on our incredible sailboat. Whether you choose some relaxing downtime or a buzzing activity, every moment is about pleasure and freedom.
<b>Day 6 - Friday</b> BELIZE CITY	Belize City is the country's main port and former capital, and an ideal set-off point for exploring the jungle Mayan ruins of Lamanai. This stopover is also a chance to discover Belize's emblematic lively, colourful, and festive culture. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
<b>Day 7 - Saturday</b> LIVINGSTON	Nestled on the Caribbean coast, Livingston's unique charm comes from its blend of Garifuna and Mayan cultures. Accessible only by boat, this stopover invites you to discover tropical rhythms and an authentic culture within an exceptional natural setting. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
<b>Day 8 - Sunday</b> GUANAJA	Known as the "hidden pearl" of the Caribbean, Guanaja is famous for its unspoiled scenery and crystal-clear waters. Lined by pristine beaches and coral reefs, this authentic island is ideal for relaxing or exploring its lush nature and fascinating marine life. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
<b>Day 9 - Monday</b> SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA	Live the dream thanks to a wealth of onboard experiences on our incredible sailboat. Whether you choose some relaxing downtime or a buzzing activity, every moment is about pleasure and freedom.
<b>Day 10 - Tuesday</b> PORT ANTONIO	Port Antonio showcases a buzzing side to Jamaica, where life follows a reggae rhythm and the hospitality is sincere. From the fast waters of the Rio Grande to the deep blue lagoons, nature displays all its glory in a setting that could be straight out of a film. An exclusive stopover blending authenticity and tropical splendour. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

<b>Day 12 - Thursday</b> ÎLE CATALINA	Catalina Island is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, home to white sandy beaches and unspoiled coral reefs. The beach will be privatised for an exclusive 'Caribbean Beach Club' day, perfect for a luxurious, relaxing break in a superb natural setting. Anchored boat, water sports at the beach (excluding water skiing).
<b>Day 13 - Friday</b> LA ROMANA	Officially founded in 1897, this southern Dominican Republic port town owes its development to the installation of a large sugar cane mill built by Italian immigrants some twenty years later. It was first established in 1851 to facilitate maritime traffic, meaning the port has played a key role in the region's economic development. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

## Excursions of your cruise

<p><b>Day 2 - Monday</b> BOCA DEL TORO / CACAO &amp; LANCHAS (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Set out with your guide to discover the archipelago, in particular its cocoa production. Travel in a lancha boat to the plantation and wander through the paths to find out where fermentation, drying and roasting take place. You will also learn about the history of cocoa and of course taste some of Bocas' black gold!</p>
<p><b>Day 2 - Monday</b> BOCAS DEL TORO / CAYO ZAPATILLAS BY LOCAL SPEEDBOAT (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Set off by local speedboat to explore the Caribbean gem, Cayo Zapatillas. White sandy beaches and turquoise waters welcome you to this tropical paradise. Admire the vibrant coral reefs and the richness of marine life from the shore. Don't forget your swimsuit to enjoy a refreshing swim in these crystal-clear waters. Relax and soak in the tranquility of this secluded island. Depending on sea conditions, the navigation may be more dynamic and require good physical condition.</p>
<p><b>Day 2 - Monday</b> BOCA DEL TORO / DOLFIN BAY (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Set off to explore the Dolphin Lagoon of San Cristobal, a protected natural environment. Enjoy a scenic boat ride in search of dolphins, following strict environmental regulations. Continue through the crystal-clear waterways surrounding Cayo Coral. Discover the rich marine life and ecosystems, including starfish, corals, mangroves, and tropical species. Stop at Cayo Coral for free time at a restaurant and bar built on stilts, surrounded by stunning scenery. Return towards Isla Colón and Club Med 2 after a memorable nature-filled excursion. Depending on sea conditions, the navigation may be more dynamic and require good physical condition.</p>
<p><b>Day 3 - Tuesday</b> LIMON / THE CANALS OF TORTUGUERO (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>This 2-hour tour by local boat through the canals linking the Tortuguero area, is filled with incredible scenery, wildlife and greenery in all its authentic diversity. The trip starts at the Moin wharf and takes you to one of the country's most beautiful regions: the canals of Tortuguero. You'll have the chance to discover the rainforest and all its biodiversity directly from the aquatic environment, which is home to numerous birds, reptiles, insects and mammals. If you love photography or immersing yourself in nature, this is the tour for you!</p>
<p><b>Day 3 - Tuesday</b> LIMÓN / THE CAHUITA NATIONAL PARK (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Cahuita National Park, located on Costa Rica's Caribbean coast, is a natural gem offering visitors a unique experience. The park is famous for its pristine beaches and coral reefs, perfect for snorkeling and scuba diving. The lush rainforest is home to a wide variety of wildlife, including monkeys, sloths and a host of exotic birds. Hiking trails allow you to explore the diverse landscape, from mangroves to palm-fringed beaches. When you visit Cahuita, you'll discover not only the natural beauty but also the cultural richness of the region, with its strong Afro-Caribbean influences. It's an ideal place for nature lovers, marine enthusiasts and those seeking an authentic immersion in local culture. Lunch included. This tour involves 1 hour 30 min of driving.</p>
<p><b>Day 3 - Tuesday</b> LIMÓN / WILDLIFE LEGENDS: TALES OF ANIMALS THROUGH TIME (JRC) (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>The Jaguar Rescue Animal Rehabilitation Center, located on the Caribbean coast of Costa Rica, is a sanctuary dedicated to the rehabilitation and protection of wildlife. The center offers a unique opportunity to get up close and personal with local wildlife, learn about the history of each resident and learn more about conservation efforts in the region. Founded with the aim of rescuing, rehabilitating and reintroducing wild animals, the center is home to a variety of species. The Jaguar Rescue Center is a must-see destination for nature lovers and those interested in supporting wildlife protection. As the center receives no government support, entrance fees charged for visits, as well as income from the small souvenir store, are its only source of revenue. PS: The diversity of animals varies according to the vulnerable fauna brought to the center by conservation organizations or local residents. Local Lunch included. This tour involves 1 hour 30 min of driving.</p>
<p><b>Day 4 - Wednesday</b> SAN ANDRES - PANORAMA DE SAN ANDRES (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Enjoy a beautiful sunny day in the most recognized island of Colombia, known by its beautiful beaches and white sand. With your english driver, you will discover the must of this island during the panoramic tour of the island.</p>
<p><b>Day 6 - Friday</b> BELIZE / MAYA CITY OF LAMANAI (full day)*</p>	<p>Cross the lagoon by lancha to get to Lamanai where you can tour the remains of this ancient Maya city. Here, you will discover imposing buildings, such as the Jaguar Temple and the High Temple, from the tops of which you will get an uninterrupted view of the ruins, the tropical forest and the New River. This tour involves 2 hours of driving and 3 hours fast boat ride.</p>
<p><b>Day 10 - Tuesday</b> PORT ANTONIO / CRUISING ON THE RIO GRANDE (1/2 day)*</p>	<p>Come and discover the unspoiled green landscapes of Jamaica as you gently float down the Rio Grande, at the heart of a region that's recently been awarded Unesco World Heritage status. Relaxing comfortably on a two-person bamboo raft, 7 metres long, this mini-cruise is your chance to appreciate the extraordinary beauty of the river as it winds between the Blue Mountains. Listen to the birdsong and follow the meandering curves of the river through the verdant tropical vegetation... and why not enjoy a refreshing swim?</p>
<p><b>Day 13 - Friday</b> LA ROMANA / ONE DAY TO PUNTA CANA RESORT (1day)*</p>	<p>Before your flight, enjoy a wonderful day at the Punta Cana Resort, relax on its magnificent coconut palm beach and enjoy the Dominican atmosphere. Day pass from 10.30am to 4pm. Return directly to the airport of Punta Cana.</p>
<p><b>Day 13 - Friday</b> LA ROMANA / CAVE OF WONDERS (1/2 day, morning)*</p>	<p>Explore the amazing 240 square metres of the Cave of Wonders. In the midst of stalactites, columns and other rock formations, you will discover ancient drawings left behind by the first indigenous people of the Caribbean. ## Formalities

### HEALTH FORMALITIES

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Some parasitic or viral diseases can be carried by mosquitoes during certain stopovers. The use of skin and clothing repellents is therefore recommended. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
