





Excursions of your cruise

Day 2 - Saturday ROSEAU/ UNUSUAL SWIMS IN DOMINICA (1/2 day)*

Travel to the untamed summits of the island, and after a short walk you will come to a natural rock pool and narrow canyon fed by a waterfall where you can swim surrounded by nature. (Undeveloped natural site). Continue to the village of Wotten Waven, also known as the Wellness Village for its therapeutic pools fed by hot sulphur water. Be sure to take a soothing bath in the midst of fumaroles and porous volcanic rocks.

Day 2 - Saturday ROSEAU/ NATURAL WONDERS OF DOMINICA (1/2 day)*

Come and enjoy the most popular natural attractions that Dominica has to offer! Spanny Falls are still a bit of a secret, even though they are the height of a 7-story building. Continue on to the Trois Pitons National Park, and cross the forest to the Emerald Pool and its 12-metre waterfall where you can cool off (undeveloped area). You will finally make your way to the village of Trafalgar to the viewing platform to see the majestic waterfalls that the village is famous for before returning to the boat.

Day 12 - Tuesday FUNCHAL - LAURISSILVA BY 4X4 - UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE*

Explore the fantastic laurel forest in open top land covers! Get off the beaten track, to reach the fabulous vineyards of northern Madeira, visit the charming Quinta do Barbusano and taste its local table wines while sharing some tapas before returning to Funchal

Day 12 - Tuesday FUNCHAL - MONTE & JARDIN BOTANIQUE (1/2day)*

The village of Monte is world famous for its many beautiful properties and gardens, perched on a hill above Funchal. Discover its church dating from the 18th century before admiring the breathtaking panorama from the cable car that you will take for your walk in the botanical gardens. 1

Day 15 - Friday MALAGA / MALAGA AND CATHEDRAL*

Discover the charm of Malaga on a journey through both its historic heart and modern districts. Guided through the city's lively streets, you will experience the unique blend of tradition, culture, and contemporary life that defines this Andalusian city. The highlight of the visit is the Cathedral of Malaga, a magnificent example of Spanish Renaissance architecture. Known as La Manquita, the cathedral impresses with its elegant proportions, rich artistic heritage, and fascinating history.
