Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Friday ALICANTE	Nicknamed the White Citadel by the Greeks and the City of Light by the Romans, this destination combines history and Mediterranean charm. Its historic quarter, bustling port, and sunny beaches showcase its deep connection with the sea. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
Day 2 - Saturday VALENCIA	The gothic architecture of the Lonja de la Seda (Silk Exchange) UNESCO World Heritage Site covers over 2,000 m ² . Directly opposite, the Mercado Central invites you to explore one of Europe's most beautiful covered markets. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
Day 3 - Sunday PALMA DE MALLORCA	Overlooked by its impressive cathedral, one of Spain's finest Gothic masterpieces, Palma de Mallorca blends modern life with tradition. The capital of the Balearic Islands, the city's architectural heritage and unique Mediterranean ambience make it a charming stopover. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
Day 4 - Monday MAHÓN	The port of Mahon showcases the authentic charm of Menorca, AKA "the blue and white island". Between unspoiled coves and spectacular cliffs, the island is home to a unique megalithic past: navetas, taules, and talayots bear witness to a thousand years of history. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
Day 5 - Tuesday BARCELONA	This beautiful Catalan city blends tradition and modernity with a lively atmosphere. Its buzzing districts and Las Ramblas promenade are a feast for the senses both day and night. Boat docked, dive locker closed, no direct access to the beach. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
Day 6 - Wednesday COLLIOURE	Nestled between the Mediterranean and the Pyrenees, Collioure inspired great masters such as Matisse and Chagall. Its cobbled streets wind between two picturesque harbours, lined with brightly coloured Catalan boats. Boat at anchor, access to the beach, and water sports available.
Day 7 - Thursday MARSEILLE	Founded in 600 BC by sailors from Phocaea, Marseille reveals a rich and contrasting heritage. The Old Port, the narrow streets of its historic districts, the basilica of Notre-Dame-de-la-Garde, the sunlit corniche, and the wild calanques create a unique setting, blending tradition and modernity. Ship docked, no water sports.
Day 8 - Friday NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

Excursions of your cruise

Day 2 - Saturday VALENCE - HISTORICAL VALENCE (1/2 day)*

Come and discover the heart and soul of Valencia, one of Spain's most vibrant and dynamic cities. Accompanied by your guide, explore the city's most emblematic neighborhoods and immerse yourself in its rich history and lively atmosphere.

Your visit includes Valencia's iconic landmarks: the impressive Serrano Towers, the bustling Central Market, and the magnificent Gothic Cathedral, a powerful symbol of the city's Moorish and Christian heritage. (Please note: Sundays & on November 2nd, 2026, when the Cathedral is closed, the visit will be replaced by La Lonja de la Seda, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.)

This excursion offers the perfect introduction to Valencia, blending history, architecture, and local life for an unforgettable cultural experience.

Day 3 - Sunday PALMA DE MALLORCA / VALDEMOSSA, SOLLER*

Made famous by the stay of George Sand and Frédéric Chopin during the winter of 1839, the charming village of Valldemossa will enchant you with its traditional Majorcan houses and picturesque pedestrian streets, beautifully decorated with colorful hanging flower pots that fill the village with fragrance and charm. The journey continues to the village of Sóller, nestled in the heart of a deep and fertile valley. Renowned for its citrus groves, Sóller owes its name to this rich agricultural heritage. You will have the opportunity to experience the historic tramway connecting Sóller to its port, enjoying the scenic ride through the lush landscape. Afterward, savor a delicious lunch at the restaurant Mar & Sol, offering exquisite local flavors and an inviting atmosphere by the sea. A perfect excursion combining history, culture, scenic landscapes, and authentic Majorcan cuisine.

Day 3 - Sunday PALMA DE MALLORCA / PALMA HISTORIQUE ET SA CATHÉDRALE*

Explore the historic center of Palma and be captivated by the stunning architecture of this Mediterranean city. Visit the majestic Palma Cathedral, a Gothic masterpiece overlooking the sea. Book your visit now for an unforgettable experience!

Day 4 - Monday MAHON / MAHON AND THE MONTE TORO*

After a tour of the best views in the bustling centre of Mahon, the capital of Menorca since the 17th century, you'll travel to Monte Toro. As this is the highest peak, you can enjoy panoramic views of the entire island.

Day 6 - Wednesday COLLIOURE - PANORAMA OF COLLIOURE*

Travel by little train through the Collioure vineyards to Fort Saint-Elme, which dominates the Côte Vermeille from the crest of a ridge. Explore the fort and its history (outside discovery) before going back to Collioure. Then take a guided walk around the town, spotting copies of works by Matisse and Derain positioned where the originals were painted.

Day 7 - Thursday MARSEILLE / CASSIS EN BUS*

Take the Route des Crêtes to reach this little fishing port, a genuine natural gem, nestled between two incredible sites: Cap Canaille and the famous Massif des Calanques. The imposing cliffs and the sea stretching out as far as the eye can see constitute the breathtaking scenery. You will discover the secret charm of this charming village by walking through the narrow alleys and squares lined with colourful fishermen's houses, a postcard landscape!

Day 8 - Friday NICE / MEDIEVAL EZE AND ITS EXOTIC GARDEN*

After admiring the wonderful landscapes of the Riviera through the middle cornice, you will visit one of the most picturesque perched villages in the region. You will walk through the alleys of the small medieval village of Eze to discover all the hidden charm. You will then visit the exotic garden that fills the ruins of the medieval castle and contemplate the most beautiful view of the Côte d'Azur and the Bay of Beaulieu in particular.

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
