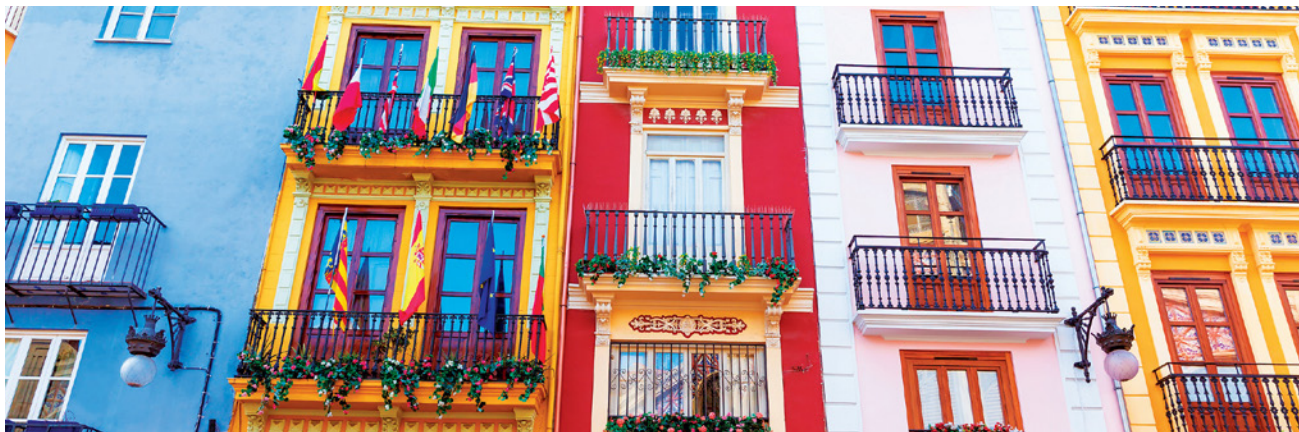

YOUR ITINERARY



DAY 1 - FRIDAY 23 APRIL

ALICANTE

Nicknamed the White Citadel by the Greeks and the City of Light by the Romans, this destination combines history and Mediterranean charm. Its historic quarter, bustling port, and sunny beaches showcase its deep connection with the sea. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

DAY 3 - SUNDAY 25 APRIL

PALMA DE MALLORCA

Overlooked by its impressive cathedral, one of Spain's finest Gothic masterpieces, Palma de Mallorca blends modern life with tradition. The capital of the Balearic Islands, the city's architectural heritage and unique Mediterranean ambience make it a charming stopover. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

DAY 2 - SATURDAY 24 APRIL

VALENCIA

The gothic architecture of the Lonja de la Seda (Silk Exchange) UNESCO World Heritage Site covers over 2,000 m². Directly opposite, the Mercado Central invites you to explore one of Europe's most beautiful covered markets. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

DAY 4 - MONDAY 26 APRIL

MAHÓN

The port of Mahon showcases the authentic charm of Menorca, AKA "the blue and white island". Between unspoiled coves and spectacular cliffs, the island is home to a unique megalithic past: navetas, taules, and talayots bear witness to a thousand years of history. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

DAY 5 - TUESDAY 27 APRIL

BARCELONA

This beautiful Catalan city blends tradition and modernity with a lively atmosphere. Its buzzing districts and Las Ramblas promenade are a feast for the senses both day and night. Boat docked, dive locker closed, no direct access to the beach. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

DAY 7 - THURSDAY 29 APRIL

MARSEILLE

Founded in 600 BCE by Greek sailors from Phocaea, the Old Port and its historic neighbourhoods, the Byzantine-style Notre-Dame-de-la-Garde basilica, its sunny corniche facing the sea and its wild rocky inlets make it a city of great contrasts. Ship docked, no water sports.

DAY 6 - WEDNESDAY 28 APRIL

COLLIOURE

Nestled between the Mediterranean and the Pyrenees, Collioure inspired great masters such as Matisse and Chagall. Its cobbled streets wind between two picturesque harbours, lined with brightly coloured Catalan boats. Boat at anchor, access to the beach, and water sports available.

DAY 8 - FRIDAY 30 APRIL

NICE

From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

DAY 2 - SATURDAY 24 APRIL

VALENCE - HISTORICAL VALENCE (1/2 DAY)*

Docked until 18:00

Come and discover the heart and soul of Valencia, one of Spain's most vibrant and dynamic cities. Accompanied by your guide, explore the city's most emblematic neighborhoods and immerse yourself in its rich history and lively atmosphere.

Your visit includes Valencia's iconic landmarks: the impressive Serrano Towers, the bustling Central Market (closed on Sundays) and the magnificent Gothic Cathedral, a powerful symbol of the city's Moorish and Christian heritage. (Please note: Sundays & on November 2nd, 2026, when the Cathedral is closed, the visit will be replaced by La Lonja de la Seda, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.)

PALMA DE MALLORCA / VALDEMOSSA, SOLLER*

Docked until 18:00

Made famous by the stay of George Sand and Frédéric Chopin during the winter of 1839, the charming village of Valldemossa will enchant you with its traditional Majorcan houses and picturesque pedestrian streets, beautifully decorated with colorful hanging flower pots that fill the village with fragrance and charm. The journey continues to the village of Sóller, nestled in the heart of a deep and fertile valley. Renowned for its citrus groves, Sóller owes its name to this rich agricultural heritage. You will have the opportunity to experience the historic tramway connecting Sóller to its port, enjoying the scenic ride through the lush landscape. Afterward, savor a delicious lunch at the restaurant Mar & Sol, offering exquisite local flavors and an inviting atmosphere by the sea. A perfect excursion combining history, culture, scenic landscapes, and authentic Majorcan cuisine.

MAHON / MAHON AND THE MONTE TORO*

MARSEILLE / CASSIS EN BUS*

Docked until 18:00

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

To make the most of your cruise with complete peace of mind, here is some information to keep in mind.



CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and

may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return. We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence. Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
