The Legacy of the Ancient World

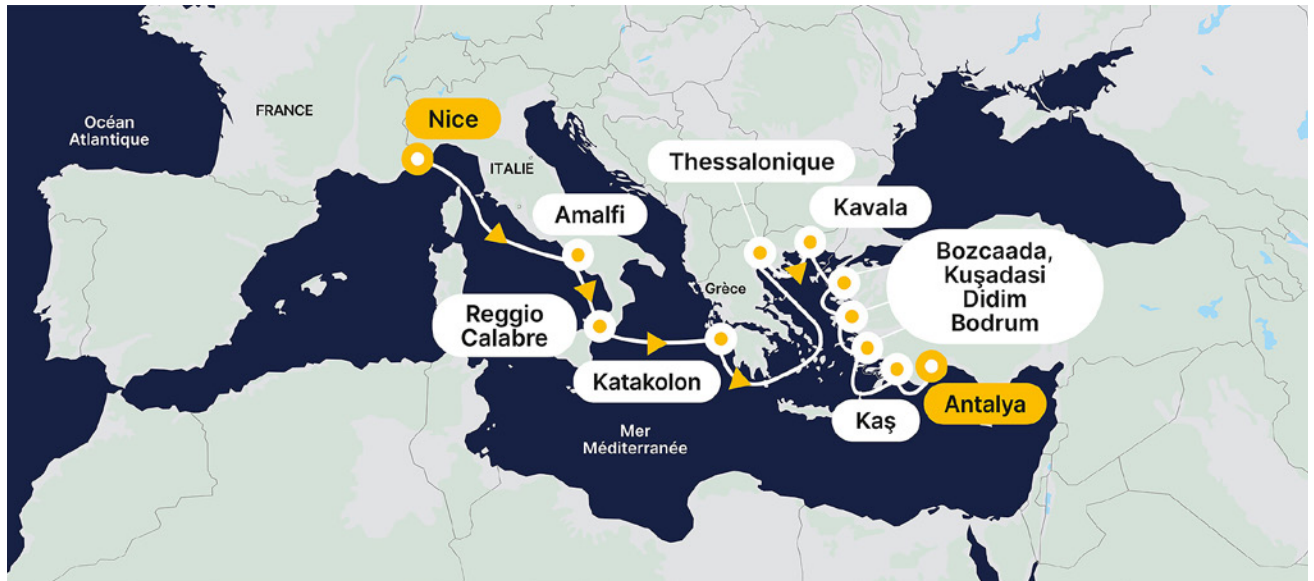

DAY 1 - FRIDAY 11 JUNE NICE

DAY 3 - SUNDAY 13 JUNE AMALFI

DAY 7 - THURSDAY 17 JUNE THESSALONIKI

A cosmopolitan Aegean Sea city, Thessaloniki showcases a rich Byzantine heritage and Ottoman influences. With archaeological sites, famous museums, and seafront promenades, it elegantly blends history, culture, and the Mediterranean lifestyle. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

DAY 6 - WEDNESDAY 16 JUNE SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA

DAY 8 - FRIDAY 18 JUNE KAVALA

DAY 9 - SATURDAY 19 JUNE

BOZCAADA

Overlooked by a magnificent medieval fort, this unspoiled island is a timeless refuge. Cobble streets and whitewashed houses that cling to the hillside reveal a discreet blend of Turkish and Greek influences. With sunny beaches and famous vineyards, Bozcaada blends a mild Mediterranean climate with a rich cultural heritage. Boat at anchor, water sports available.

DAY 11 - MONDAY 21 JUNE

DIDYMA

An ancient spiritual centre, Didim is home to Apollo's oracle, which rivalled that of Delphi. Its huge temple mirrors the splendour of the Temple of Artemis in Ephesus, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. With its impressive ruins and sun-kissed Aegean coastline, this stopover blends history with the Mediterranean's beauty. Boat at anchor, water sports available.

DAY 10 - SUNDAY 20 JUNE

KUŞADASI

A buzzing port on the Aegean coast, Kuşadası is a short hop from Ephesus, a World Heritage-listed archaeological marvel. Its ancient 24,000-seat amphitheatre bears witness to the city's artistic and intellectual prowess. With impressive ruins, sunny beaches, and colourful bazaars, this port blends culture with a mild Mediterranean climate. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

DAY 12 - TUESDAY 22 JUNE

BODRUM

Overlooked by a stately medieval castle, the town has lively streets, whitewashed houses, and a buzzing harbour. Once known as Halicarnassus, it is home to the Mausoleum of Halicarnassus, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. With golden beaches, chic marinas, and impressive ruins, Bodrum is combines history with a Mediterranean lifestyle. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

DAY 13 - WEDNESDAY 23 JUNE

KAŞ

This charming seaside town has a picture-postcard harbour and narrow streets lined with whitewashed houses. An ancient Lycian city with an authentic atmosphere, home to ancient ruins and coves with crystal-clear waters. With panoramic views over the neighbouring Greek islands, Kaş is a stopover that blends nature and history. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.

DAY 14 - THURSDAY 24 JUNE

ANTALYA

Known as the "Turkish Riviera", Antalya is the country's most popular seaside resort. Its old town, Kaleiçi, showcases Ottoman houses with finely carved woodwork, mosques, and shop-lined cobbled streets. A stopover combining Mediterranean charm with a rich cultural heritage. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening

test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return. We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence. Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
