







<b>Day 1 - Friday</b> NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
<b>Day 2 - Saturday</b> SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA	Let yourself be lulled by the soothing rhythm of the waves and savour every moment aboard our exceptional sailboat. Relax on the decks' sun loungers, enjoy a refreshing dip in one of our two pools, work up a sweat in the Fitness Centre or treat yourself to wellness break at the spa... Live life at your own pace. Our friendly and attentive GO team and crew will be on hand to make your day as fun as it is unforgettable.
<b>Day 3 - Sunday</b> AMALFI	A maritime republic with a splendid promenade and a cathedral with numerous secret, metaphysical symbols, Amalfi has a host of assets: wonderful nature and plenty of panoramic views of the fabulous coastline. Boat at anchor, no water sports and no direct access to a beach.
<b>Day 4 - Monday</b> REGGIO CALABRIA	A southern Italian town facing Sicily with a promenade and a rich ancient heritage, including the famous Riace Bronzes. With its Greek heritage, Mediterranean vibe, and Messina Strait view, this authentic stopover blends culture and nature. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
<b>Day 5 - Tuesday</b> KATAKOLON	This small port full of cafés and boutiques is the gateway to Olympia, the city that hosted the first Olympic Games. The atmosphere is reminiscent of pastoral life in a bygone era. Ship docked, no water sports, beach.
<b>Day 6 - Wednesday</b> SAILING ON THE OPEN SEA	Live the dream thanks to a wealth of onboard experiences on our incredible sailboat. Whether you choose some relaxing downtime or a buzzing activity, every moment is about pleasure and freedom.
<b>Day 7 - Thursday</b> THESSALONIKI	A cosmopolitan Aegean Sea city, Thessaloniki showcases a rich Byzantine heritage and Ottoman influences. With archaeological sites, famous museums, and seafront promenades, it elegantly blends history, culture, and the Mediterranean lifestyle. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
<b>Day 8 - Friday</b> KAVALA	A timeless, charming Greek port dating back to the VII <sup>e</sup> century. This city has an oriental atmosphere and views bathed in light. Its historic landmarks are lined with flowerbeds, perfect for a leisurely stroll. Each alleyway leads to Mount Simvolos and its spectacular views across the Aegean Sea. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
<b>Day 9 - Saturday</b> BOZCAADA	Overlooked by a magnificent medieval fort, this unspoiled island is a timeless refuge. Cobble streets and whitewashed houses that cling to the hillside reveal a discreet blend of Turkish and Greek influences. With sunny beaches and famous vineyards, Bozcaada blends a mild Mediterranean climate with a rich cultural heritage. Boat at anchor, water sports available.
<b>Day 10 - Sunday</b> KUŞADASI	A buzzing port on the Aegean coast, Kuşadası is a short hop from Ephesus, a World Heritage-listed archaeological marvel. Its ancient 24,000-seat amphitheatre bears witness to the city's artistic and intellectual prowess. With impressive ruins, sunny beaches, and colourful bazaars, this port blends culture with a mild Mediterranean climate. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
<b>Day 11 - Monday</b> DIDYMA	An ancient spiritual centre, Didim is home to Apollo's oracle, which rivaled that of Delphi. Its huge temple mirrors the splendour of the Temple of Artemis in Ephesus, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. With its impressive ruins and sun-kissed Aegean coastline, this stopover blends history with the Mediterranean's beauty. Boat at anchor, water sports available.
<b>Day 12 - Tuesday</b> BODRUM	Overlooked by a stately medieval castle, the town has lively streets, whitewashed houses, and a buzzing harbour. Once known as Halicarnassus, it is home to the Mausoleum of Halicarnassus, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. With golden beaches, chic marinas, and impressive ruins, Bodrum combines history with a Mediterranean lifestyle. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
<b>Day 13 - Wednesday</b> KAŞ	This charming seaside town has a picture-postcard harbour and narrow streets lined with whitewashed houses. An ancient Lycian city with an authentic atmosphere, home to ancient ruins and coves with crystal-clear waters. With panoramic views over the neighbouring Greek islands, Kaş is a stopover that blends nature and history. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
<b>Day 14 - Thursday</b> ANTALYA	Known as the "Turkish Riviera", Antalya is the country's most popular seaside resort. Its old town, Kaleiçi, showcases Ottoman houses with finely carved woodwork, mosques, and shop-lined cobble streets. A stopover combining Mediterranean charm with a rich cultural heritage. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
<b>Day 15 - Friday</b> ALANYA	The Turkish coastal city of Alanya combines relaxation with history. Its sandy beach by a clear sea reaches the foot of a Seljuk fortress that has guarded the town since the XIII <sup>e</sup> century. Ancient ruins, medieval towers, and caravanserais recall its former strategic role on the Spice Route. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
<b>Day 16 - Saturday</b> PAPHOS	The mythical birthplace of Aphrodite, Paphos combines legends and history. The goddess of love and beauty is said to have been born from the sea foam off its coast. The emperors Augustus and Tiberius rebuilt parts of the island, landmarks that are now World Heritage Sites. With myths, ancient ruins, and a mild Mediterranean climate, this stopover harks back to the birth of civilisation. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
<b>Day 17 - Sunday</b> ALEXANDRIA	Founded by Alexander the Great, Alexandria was once the Mediterranean's largest cultural hub. The ancient Lighthouse is one of the Seven Wonders, while the Library recalls the illustrious history of the Nile's banks. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
<b>Day 18 - Monday</b> ALEXANDRIA	Founded by Alexander the Great, Alexandria was once the Mediterranean's largest cultural hub. The ancient Lighthouse is one of the Seven Wonders, while the Library recalls the illustrious history of the Nile's banks. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

Its picturesque harbour and cobbled streets are just waiting to be explored, while its jagged shores and turquoise Mediterranean waters are lined with unspoiled bays and coves. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
<b>Day 23 - Saturday</b> ATHENS	The Greek capital opens the pages of its age-old history. In the heart of modernity, the Acropolis and the narrow streets of the Plaka district reveal their splendour and charm. Ship docked. Passengers may board and disembark here.

## Formalities

### CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

### HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
