YOUR ITINERARY



DAY 1 - THURSDAY 24 JUNE

ANTALYA

Known as the "Turkish Riviera", Antalya is the country's most popular seaside resort. Its old town, Kaleiçi, showcases Ottoman houses with finely carved woodwork, mosques, and shop-lined cobbled streets. A stopover combining Mediterranean charm with a rich cultural heritage. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

DAY 3 - SATURDAY 26 JUNE

PAPHOS

The mythical birthplace of Aphrodite, Paphos combines legends and history. The goddess of love and beauty is said to have been born from the sea foam off its coast. The emperors Augustus and Tiberius rebuilt parts of the island, landmarks that are now World Heritage Sites. With myths, ancient ruins, and a mild Mediterranean climate, this stopover harks back to the birth of civilisation. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.

DAY 2 - FRIDAY 25 JUNE

ALANYA

The Turkish coastal city of Alanya combines relaxation with history. Its sandy beach by a clear sea reaches the foot of a Seljuk fortress that has guarded the town since the XIII^e century. Ancient ruins, medieval towers, and caravanserais recall its former strategic role on the Spice Route. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

DAY 4 - SUNDAY 27 JUNE

ALEXANDRIA

Founded by Alexander the Great, Alexandria was once the Mediterranean's largest cultural hub. The ancient Lighthouse is one of the Seven Wonders, while the Library recalls the illustrious history of the Nile's banks. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.

DAY 5 - MONDAY 28 JUNE ALEXANDRIA

DAY 9 - FRIDAY 2 JULY

CHANIA

Nicknamed the "Diamond of Crete", Chania has a fascinating blend of Venetian, Ottoman, and Greek architecture that showcases its multi-faceted history. Its picturesque harbour and cobbled streets are just waiting to be explored, while its jagged shores and turquoise Mediterranean waters are lined with unspoiled bays and coves. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.

DAY 10 - SATURDAY 3 JULY

ATHENS

The Greek capital opens the pages of its age-old history. In the heart of modernity, the Acropolis and the narrow streets of the Plaka district reveal their splendour and charm. Ship docked. Passengers may board and disembark here.

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and

may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return. We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence. Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy. A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
