





Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday PALERMO	The historic centre holds an irresistible fascination for visitors. The civilisations that helped weave its history have left their mark on the sun-scorched stones and the shady little streets. Boat docked, no water sports and no direct access to a beach. Passengers boarding and disembarking at this port of call.
Day 2 - Sunday MAZARA DEL VALLO	Situated in the heart of the Mediterranean, Mazara del Vallo is known for its strategic role and unique heritage. Its historic centre has Arab, Norman, and Italian influences, creating a fascinating blend of architectural styles. Its picturesque narrow streets, a lively port, and culinary heritage make it a magnet for visitors after authenticity and Mediterranean charm. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
Day 3 - Monday SOUSSE	Observation of the total eclipse off the Tunisian coast, followed by a continuation to Sousse, known as "the Pearl of the Sahel." The city reflects the urban planning of the early centuries of Islam, with its kasbah, ramparts, and Great Mosque. Its UNESCO-listed Medina forms a unique architectural complex, reflecting its rich Arab-Muslim heritage. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
Day 4 - Tuesday SOUSSE	Known as "the Pearl of the Sahel." The city reflects the urban planning of the early centuries of Islam, with its kasbah, ramparts, and Great Mosque. Its UNESCO-listed Medina forms a unique architectural complex, reflecting its rich Arab-Muslim heritage. Boat at anchor, dive locker closed.
Day 5 - Wednesday PORTO EMPEDOCLE/ AGRIGENTE	An entry point to Agrigento, Porto Empedocle boasts a charming maritime atmosphere and beaches bathed in light. A few kilometres away, Agrigento is home to the majestic Valley of the Temples, an archaeological UNESCO World Heritage Site. With its ancient ruins, Mediterranean views, and Sicilian traditions, this authentic, history-packed destination promises an unforgettable experience. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
Day 6 - Thursday SYRACUSE	Ortigia, the town's original historic centre, on a peninsula in the heart of the city, is a blend of Baroque, Gothic, Norman and Greek influences. Ship docked, no water sports and no direct access to a beach.
Day 7 - Friday GIARDINI NAXOS/ TAORMINA	With the splendour of the coast on one side and the stately beauty of Mount Etna on the other, Taormina's lofty position on Mount Tauro gives it stunning views. The ancient Greco-Roman theatre is just one of the town's interesting historical sights. Ship at anchor, water sports not available.
Day 8 - Saturday PALERMO	The historic centre holds an irresistible fascination for visitors. CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
