





Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday PALERMO	The historic centre holds an irresistible fascination for visitors. The civilisations that helped weave its history have left their mark on the sun-scorched stones and the shady little streets. Boat docked, no water sports and no direct access to a beach. Passengers boarding and disembarking at this port of call.
Day 2 - Sunday LIPARI	The island's volcanic origins have forged the most astonishing landscapes. Invaded time and again, its citadel reveals the island's multi-faceted personality through the multiple influences of its architecture. Ship at anchor. No Water sports.
Day 3 - Sunday CATANIA	Catania is Sicily's second-largest city and dates back thousands of years. Home to the Byzantines, Arabs, and Normans, this city has Baroque palaces, churches, and ruins at the foot of Mount Etna. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
Day 4 - Tuesday GALLIPOLI	Gallipoli, meaning "beautiful city" in Greek, honours past and future with its mix of contemporary architecture in the borgo and the splendour of its ancient palaces in the historic centre. Ship at anchor, water sports available (no water skiing), no direct access to a beach.
Day 5 - Wednesday PARGA	This picturesque hillside harbour town has superb views of the bay and the Ionian islands. From the covered walkway of the Venetian citadel, the grandiose views of this historical seaside setting are well worth the climb. Boat at anchor, water sports available.
Day 6 - Thursday KATAKOLON	This small port full of cafés and boutiques is the gateway to Olympia, the city that hosted the first Olympic Games. The atmosphere is reminiscent of pastoral life in a bygone era. Ship docked, no water sports, beach.
Day 7 - Friday CYTHERA	The mythical birthplace of Aphrodite, this island's timeless beauty has inspired painters and poets alike. Located just off the Peloponnese, it is a peaceful getaway with rocky coves and deserted beaches beside calm waters. Boat at anchor, water sports available.
Day 8 - Saturday ATHENS	The Greek capital opens the pages of its age-old history. In the heart of modernity, the Acropolis and the narrow streets of the Plaka district reveal their splendour and charm. Ship docked at the port of Piraeus, no nautical activities planned. Passengers may board and disembark here.

Formalities

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.
