





## Itinerary of your cruise

<b>Day 1 - Saturday</b> NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
<b>Day 2 - Sunday</b> SÈTE	Located between the Mediterranean and the Étang de Thau, famous for its oysters, Sète is also known as the "Venice of the Languedoc" because of its network of canals. It has retained its old world charm thanks to the ports located in the heart of the city. Boat docked, dive locker closed, stopover without beach.
<b>Day 3 - Monday</b> BARCELONE	Barcelona is a vibrant cocktail of tradition and avant-garde, where culture and fun combine to ensure a fabulous stay. By night or day, the Ramblas and the barrios are a feast for the senses. Ship docked, no water sports and no direct access to a beach. Stopover for boarding and disembarking.
<b>Day 4 - Tuesday</b> PALMA DE MALLORCA	Dominated by its imposing cathedral, considered to be one of the most beautiful Gothic structures in Spain, the capital of the Balearic Islands has a twin identity, combining modernism and traditions. Ship docked, no water sports.
<b>Day 5 - Wednesday</b> ALICANTE	Nicknamed the White Citadel by the Greeks and the City of Light by the Romans, this destination combines history and Mediterranean charm. Its historic quarter, bustling port, and sunny beaches showcase its deep connection with the sea. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
<b>Day 6 - Thursday</b> CARTHAGÈNE	Brightly coloured Andalusian houses enliven Cartagena, an arid former mining city with a special Mediterranean charm. Many cultures have made Cartagena home over the centuries, leaving behind a rich artistic history that is still visible today.
<b>Day 7 - Friday</b> MOTRIL	The city's historic centre showcases traditional Hispano-Arab urban design, where every landmark is a chapter in Andalusian history. The Encarnación Church, built on the foundations of an ancient mosque, rubs shoulders with the elegant Baroque town hall. The Virgen de la Cabeza Sanctuary is on the site where King Boabdil's mother once lived, completing this discovery-packed cultural journey. Motril is the capital of the Tropical Coast, blending fascinating heritage, spirituality, and architecture. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned.
<b>Day 8 - Saturday</b> MÁLAGA	Nestled on the Costa del Sol, Málaga beautifully combines a Mediterranean climate and a rich cultural heritage. As the birthplace of Pablo Picasso, visitors interested in Cubism can tour the artist's childhood home and a museum that houses over 200 of his works. Its historic centre, buzzing alleyways and urban beaches ensure the perfect balance between art, relaxation and an easy-going lifestyle. Boat is docked, no nautical activities are planned. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

## Formalities

### CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

### HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.

Port of Nice. Commercial wharf (or sometimes Quai Admiral Infernet). The 2 docks are close, the port is small. We can not miss to see the CM2. Airport / port distance: 9 km (about 30 minutes).
